

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS – ENTRY INFORMATION

When completing entry forms, please ensure the following information is provided to ensure your dog receives the wins/scores earned at a show/trial.

1. The complete registered name of the dog – not its call name. The only exception is with listed dogs where the name may change upon registration.
2. Appropriate CKC number, i.e. Registration, Miscellaneous Class or in the case of foreign born and foreign owned dogs, ERN numbers.
3. In the case of co-owned dogs, the names of all registered owners. Dogs registered to a husband and wife are considered co-owned dogs.
4. Dogs entered in a trial by a leasee must indicate the owner of record as the owner of the dog on entry forms.
5. Names of all registered breeders.
6. Correct date of birth.
7. Correct name of sire and dam.
8. Any additional information as required by the dog show rules.
9. All entry forms must be legible – type or neatly print the information.

Please refer to your CKC Registration Certificate to verify the information required on entry forms. If the dog is registered in another country, the information on the entry form must be the same as stated in that registration certificate. The dog will be registered with the CKC based on the registration in the country of origin.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. HANDLERS and AGENTS please note the full name and address of all owners **MUST BE FILLED IN**. In complete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal disruption. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Only dogs already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close. Any NSF cheques or credit cards will be subject to a **\$20.00** service charge. Entry fee plus service charge for NSF cheques must be paid in cash prior to competing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Trial precincts shall be the interior of the Coliseum building. The Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules. The Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club and the Trial Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is not possible to open or complete the show/trials, no refund of entries will be made. Refunds will be made when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season after entries close if a Veterinarian's certificate is delivered to the Event Secretary before the date of the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded should a dog be absent, sick, lame or excused by a Veterinarian, Judge, or Superintendent. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the CKC Dog Show Rules. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Trial club to see that the judges, club officials, ring stewards, volunteers or competitors at the Trial held under these regulations are not subject to indignities of any kind.

TRANSITION CLASSES

A dog eligible for a PEN number may NOT be entered in these classes as a listed dog. **Pre Novice** is for dogs that have not earned the title of PCD (Pre Companion Dog) in Canada or has not earned the title of CD in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. This is an elective class and earning a title is not required to advance to Novice Classes. This is a pass/fail class and will be qualifying ribbons only.

Novice Intermediate is for dogs that have earned the title of CD, CDX UD or any other advanced title in Canada. Dogs may be entered in Open and Novice Intermediate at the same trial. This is an elective class and earning a title is not required to advance to Open Classes. Scores earned in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. This class will have a 1st to 3rd placing, same as the regular classes.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN OBEEDIENCE EXHIBITORS

A dog which has earned its CD title in the US is not eligible for entry in the Novice A class and a dog which has earned its CDX title in the US is not eligible for the Open A class. Such dogs must be entered in the B class respectively. Dogs with an American ILP number are NOT eligible for entry at Licensed Obedience Trials held under CKC regulations, but may be eligible for a **PEN Number** (see below). Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible for entry at Licensed Obedience Trials.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN)

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registered dog of a CKC registered breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follows: Obedience Trials, Tracking Tests, Herding Trials, Draft Dog Tests, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earthdog Test, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Test and Pointing Field Dog Tests.

To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:

1. The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC.
2. The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration.
3. The dog must be spayed or neutered.
4. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (not necessary for ILP dogs).
5. The dog cannot be on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List.
6. In case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP number.

A dog that has is eligible for a PEN **may not be entered as a Listed Dog**. Dogs may only enter events after a PEN has been issued to that dog. The cost is \$65.08.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective, January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

TO OBTAIN AN ERN NUMBER:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership (for example, an AKC Registration Certificate) with a written request for an ERN Number
2. Include with the above, a cheque, money order or MC/VISA number in the amount of \$67.28 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN Number to be sent to you.
3. FAXED requests will be accepted. Please include your MC/VISA number, expiry date, cardholder full name and signature.
4. This ERN Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed" however, failure to apply for an ERN Number within 30 days of the first event WILL result in the cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Any points or scores earned prior to January 1, 1992 are not subject to cancellation due to lack of an ERN Number. All dogs finished prior to January 1, 1992 must be CKC registered to have a title confirmed

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Rule 6.5.1 Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. The judge of an obedience/rally trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch, which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element.
Rule 6.5.2 When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

(Section 19.7, Obedience) (Section 17.7 Rally Obedience) of the Dog Show Rules states: A judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a show or trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Section 13.6.1 of the Dog Show Rules states: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than 7 days after the official closing. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Note: Dogs without a registration number (CKC, ERN, PEN) and miscellaneous class dogs entered in Obedience are required to pay the listing fee per show/trial. Overpayments may be applied to the trophy fund.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS U.S. exhibitors may pay by personal cheque on a U.S. Bank or U.S. Money Order in U.S. funds. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, cheques and money orders on U.S. banks must be "at par". Credit card charges on U.S. banks are automatically adjusted by the credit card company on the day the charge is submitted.

Fee must accompany entry. Calculate your entry fees carefully.

Make all cheques/money orders payable to the THUNDER BAY KENNEL & TRAINING CLUB. A fee of \$20.00 will be charged for an NSF cheque or credit card refusal.

Fax and E Mail entries must include VISA or Mastercard number, Expiry date, Name of Cardholder and Signature. An additional 10% of the total entry will be added for this service. Entries will be processed by The Dog House.
