To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the secretary after the closing date and time.

Official entry forms must be used.

Use a separate entry for Conformation and Obedience and Rally.

Postdated cheques will not be accepted. Overpayments will be considered donations to the trophy fund. NSF cheques are considered nonpayment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the CKC. All fees must be paid before the dog can be exhibited. All NSF cheques are subject to a \$25.00 charge.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

REGULAR CLASSES:

The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans**	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

NEW - Field Dog – shall be for any dog that has earned a title at WC or Hunt Test or placement at a Field Trial. Does not compete for points and proceeds directly to Best of Breed, divided by sex. May be spayed or neutered.

** Veterans class will be divided into 7-9 years, 9-11 years & 11 years and over.

ALTERED CLASSES: Offered for spayed and neutered dogs over 6 months of age to compete for Winners Male and Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Baby Puppy Class (3-6 Months, does not compete for Championship points)

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog & Get - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his get only

Brood Bitch & Progeny - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best Altered of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be 6 classes in all, divided by sex.

6-9 Months - for dogs 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months

9-12 Months - for dogs 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months

12-18 Months - for dogs 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be 6 classes in all, divided by sex:

7-9 years - for dogs 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

9-11 years - for dogs at least 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years

11 years and older - for dogs at least 11 years of age

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZING:

Division of prize money in Puppy & Veteran Sweepstakes is as follow:

15% of total entry will be awarded to Best in Sweeps

10% of total entry fee will be awarded to Best of Opposite in Sweeps

25% of total entry will be retained for administration purposes

The remaining 50% of total entry will be dispersed as follows:

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

LABRADOR RETRIEVER BOOSTER

The ALRC will consider the judging of Labrador Retrievers on Saturday, August 20th at NBKC under judge Tom Alexander to be a booster for the breed. In addition to the regular ribbons an appropriate award will be made to the following: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Best of Winners, Winners Male, Winners Female, and Best Puppy.

The ALRC will also give an appropriate award to Highest Qualifying Labrador Retriever at the Kennebecasis Obedience Club Trial on August 20th.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The building will open at 7:00am each day. On Thursday, August 18th, the Building will be open from 2:00pm until 9:00pm for Exhibitor setup.
- The Show & Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- To comply with Province of NB regulations NO SMOKING will be permitted within the confines of this building.
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The ALRC and River Valley Community Centre will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is enforced.
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.
- The ALRC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the ALRC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
