The following regular classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

BABY PUPPY – (3 – 6 Mths)	BRED BY EXHIBITOR
JUNIOR PUPPY (6 - 9 Mths)	OPEN
SENIOR PUPPY (9 - 12 Mths)	Jr. VETERANS (7-10 yrs)
YEARLING (12 - 18 Mths)	Sr. VETERANS (10+ yrs)
CANADIAN BRED	SPECIALS ONLY

BABY PUPPY CLASS –shall be for puppies aged 3 months to under 6 months of age. The winners of these classes will **NOT** compete for points. To be judged following the completion of the regular Specialty classes.

JR PUPPY CLASS – for puppies 6 months and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

SR. PUPPY CLASS – for puppies 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show

YEARLING CLASS – for dogs 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR shall be for dogs owned and handled by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs

JR. VETERANS CLASS shall be for dogs 7 to 10 years of age. Spayed and neutered dogs MAY compete.

SR. VETERANS CLASS – shall be for dogs 10 years of age and over. Spayed and neutered dogs MAY compete.

SPECIALS ONLY - for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or ERN and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note:** A Listed dog may be moved to Specials Only class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or ERN was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class must be received by the Show Secretary one hour prior to the opening of the show. Listing Fees will not be refunded

ALTERED OPEN CLASS: for all surgically neutered/spayed dogs will be offered. Awards include Winners Altered, Reserve Winners Altered, and Best of Breed Altered Points may not be carried over into these classes from the regular competition judging. Classes will be judged immediately following the Regular breed classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY: catalog listing only. No dog entered in this class can compete for any regular class, however may be entered and compete in any non-regular class.

The following Non-Regular classes will be provided

STUD DOG: for any sire and 2 or more of his get. Sire and get need not be owned by the same person. Class to be judged on the merits of the get.

DAM: same as above for any dam and 2 or more of her progeny.

BRACE: for 2 dogs shown by one person on one leash, do **NOT** need identical ownership.

LURE COURSING CLASS: for any dog with CKC, ASFA or AKC Field Ch. points

RACING CLASS: for any dog with NAWRA, CWA, WRA, or NOTRA points

Dogs entered in the non-regular classes must also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only, except for Stud and Dam whose progeny **MUST** be entered in a regular class. Spayed and neutered dogs may be entered but must also be entered in the Altered Classes, Veteran Classes, or Exhibition Only.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES

CHAPTER 4.1.3 –JUDGES A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES Section 3.1 Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$8.82 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3: INCOMPLETE ENTRIES Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2: DISHONORED CHEQUES Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION Section 1.4 A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

All entries must be complete, signed and must be submitted on the current official CKC entry form (back side of form not required). Entries submitted in any other size or format will be rejected. Telephone entries are not accepted. Incomplete or conditional entries, entries received without full entry fees or valid credit card numbers, or entries received by the Show Secretary after the advertised closing date/time will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayment or duplicate entries. Please type or print legibly in black ink, especially when scanning/faxing.

SHOW PRECINCTS:

The precincts of this show will be 15 feet from the outdoor ring and all facilities reserved for the exclusive use of the show-giving Club, excluding the parking lot

There will be a limited number of catalogues available at the show. Please indicate if you wish to pre-order a catalogue for \$8.00 on your entry form and include fee with your entries. **There will be ONE combined catalog for all 3 shows.**

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS:

Section 20.2. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 and over
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes dog awarded winners.

GRAND CHAMPION – NEW FOR 2013:

(synopsis only: rules and regulations posted on the CKC website)

Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points begins January 1 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms for calculating wins/points are found on the website and it is the responsibility of the dog's owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit it to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 two point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch (the latter two will be from the remaining Specials, if any, in competition).

RULES GOVERNING THIS SHOW:

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Superintendent shall have full control of these shows which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete for the balance of the show.
3. Dogs should be on the grounds one hour prior to the judging of their breed. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
4. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds. Crates/xpens are allowed at ringside but must be kept 15 feet from the ring.
5. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
6. If because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no entries will be refunded.
7. All exhibitors, handlers and patrons are expected to know and abide by the CKC Show Rules.

ATTENTION U.S. EXHIBITORS:

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog) For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events **ONLY**.)

BORDER CROSSING – A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and upon return to the USA. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. The border is extremely busy this time of year – allow plenty of time for border crossing. **EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2009** ALL US citizens returning to the USA will be required to produce an Enhanced Driver's License, Passport, Passport Card, or Nexus Card when re-entering the USA. To avoid delays in your return home, please ensure you have one of the above documents with you on your trip to Canada.

Current exchange rates between Canadian & US dollars have been fluctuating considerably. Personal cheques drawn on a US bank will be accepted, however they must be payable for the full amount of the entry fee(s).
