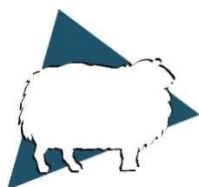

## **SET-UP**

We will be offering Coffee, Water, Snacks and Fruit, however, remember not to take the coffee and snacks into the Venue. Please come and visit us!

## **MG7 JUNIOR HANDLING**

Maritime Group 7 are offering both Junior Obedience Handling and Junior Conformation Handling as part of our Specialty. There will be a charge of \$2.00 to be paid at Registration.

The Junior Obedience Handling will take place on Friday, Sept 2nd at 1:45 pm in Ring 5. Please register with the MG7 Event Secretary any time before 1:00 pm.

The Junior Conformation Handling will take place on Saturday, Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> in Ring 3, immediately following the Soft Coated Wheaten Specialty which should be around 1 pm. Each Junior Handler must handle a Herding Dog. Please register with the MG7 Event Secretary any time before 12 noon.

## **DIRECTIONS**

From Halifax: Take NS-102 to Lantz Exit 8A. At the roundabout, take the first exit, drive to NS Hwy 2. At the roundabout take the first exit. Drive to East Hants Sportsplex, 1076 Hwy 2 (on your right).

From New Brunswick or Cape Breton: Take NS-104 to Exit 15 (Only exit to Halifax). Take NS-102 to Lantz Exit 8A. At the roundabout, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> Exit. At the 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout, take the first exit, drive to NS Hwy 2. At the roundabout take the first exit. Drive to East Hants Sportsplex, 1076 Hwy 2 (on your right).

## **PLEASE NOTE**

While no governmental Covid restrictions exist at the time this schedule is printed, should the situation change government regulations will be followed. Additionally, should any of our judges require masking in the ring, notification will be made. Please bring masks to be used in the event they are required.

Electricity within the Dome is limited. Please be kind. If you are not using the electric panel, unplug your cord so others can be accommodated.

Building regulations require that no bathing of dogs take place within the Dome. Blowing out of dogs is permitted but no liquid shampoo is to be used.

**Building regulations require that the only liquid allowed on the turf is water – no coffee, tea, soft drinks, juices or other beverages are permitted.**

**The Superintendent is in control of the precincts of the show as well as the outside parking areas and must enforce the regulations. Please do not make job more difficult by creating your own rules. We appreciate the opportunity to use this wonderful facility and work with the management to support the few restrictions that are imposed.**

**There is a Canteen on the upper floor of the main building. It will be open for breakfast, lunch and early dinner, as necessary. The food is catered and is very good. Food from that area falls under the same restriction as any other. It must be consumed in the sitting area surrounding the canteen or taken outside.**

**Restaurants within 10 minutes of the facility include: Cup of Soul, Bitar's Restorante, Irving Big Stop, McDonalds, A & W, Tim Hortons and several pizza/fast food spots.**

**Please clean up after your dogs. Bring paper towel and bottled water to deal with accidents within the dome and clean up bags for outside. It is not the responsibility of our small group of volunteers to clean up.**

**Crates and grooming tables should have a waterproof covering, eg. tarpaulin under them.**

**Bait is permitted but must not be thrown in the rings.**

**For those with a large amount of gear to unload, please us the large double doors that are around the back of the building. It will make your job easier.**

**Only RV's that have been pre-booked with Lee Steeves will be allowed to park overnight.**
