*****FLOOR CARE****

It is MANDATORY for exhibitors to cover the floor to protect against floor damage. There is no ringside grooming permitted. All grooming to take place at the exhibitor's assigned area. The use of silicone-based products and powders are prohibited. Regardless, if you use any products your ENTIRE FLOOR AREA IN YOUR ASSIGNED SPACE MUST BE COVERED WITH A WATERPROOF COVERING. The Avalon Kennel Club LOST it's previous venue due to floor damage from products used by exhibitors. Duct tape and other such adhesives are NOT to be used on the floors. Painter's tape is acceptable. If products you use result in damage to the floor or create a hazard, the facility will require that you pay for the clean-up.

The Avalon Kennel Club is NOT assuming liability for damages to the floor.

Please be advised that it is very expensive to have the products removed from the floor. By entering for this event you agree to cover your ENTIRE floor space with WATERPROOF

MATERIAL and will be held responsible for the cost of damages should they occur in the area of your assigned space.

The Avalon Kennel Club will provide <u>Assigned Exhibitor Space</u> Exhibitors will have access to Power should they require it.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- o No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- o The show secretary is unable to accept or cancel entries after the specified closing date/time.
- o Tendering of a NSF cheque as payment of entry fees shall be considered to be a non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- o Entrants must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made except as outlined in the Conformation/Obedience and Rally Show Rules. The show secretary will not be responsible for checking the accuracy of entries. Errors should be brought to the attention of the show secretary.
- o Substitution or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving class dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- o The show committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to CKC rules.
- o In the case of non-acceptance of an entry, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance.
- o Telephone, facsimile, and e-mail entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the CKC may otherwise authorize.
- o Please use separate entry forms for conformation and obedience and Rally obedience. If copying the entry forms, they must be the same size as the original.
- o The address section of the entry forms should be completed for every entry to facilitate the speedy mailing of the judging schedule and receipts.
- o If you wish your entry to be acknowledged, please include your email address.
- o The entry form must be completed in full. An incomplete entry form must be rejected by the show-giving club and returned to the designated owner or agent.
- o Every dog entered in a championship show except those breeds designated by the board, as being eligible to compete in the miscellaneous class, must be registered or eligible for registration in the studbook of the CKC.
- o No dog under the age of six (6) months is permitted within the precincts of the show, except, preregistered puppies 4-6 months of age that are with the owner who has other dog (s) entered in regular classes of the show. These puppies will not be listed in the catalogue but must be preregistered by the owner at or before the closing date and time of entries. There is also a 4-6 month Baby Puppy competition at these shows in Show 1 and Show 3. Baby Puppies must be entered by

entry form and will be listed in Catalogue. No listing fee apply to the Baby Puppy entry. BABY PUPPIES MUST HAVE A TCN

o The authorities of the shows may decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of viciousness or disease.

No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show or any official connected therewith for the refusal of an entry.

NOTIFICATIONS

**** Please note: DUE TO A RULE CHANGE WITH CKC, all conformation shows must be started each day by 10:00 am. With this in mind, and the fact that the venue can only accommodate two rings, we are obligated to move the Conformation competitions to begin at about 8:30 am or thereabout and complete both shows before starting the Performance trials in the afternoon. This is the opposite to the scheduling in the past at this venue by AKC. THE SHOW/TRIAL SCHEDULE WILL REFLECT THESE CHANGES.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one hour prior to the BREED JUDGING of the show, by the owner or handler. Please note that A DOG WITH A TCN IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE MOVED TO SPECIALS ONLY.

Please refer to the Rules and regulations for moving a dog.

THIS IS A SELF-CLEAN SHOW

All exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs whether in or out of the rings. Cleaning products will be available at ringside. If your dog soils the ring throughout judging, our ring stewards will gladly hold your dog while you clean up. Poop Bags will be available at ringside and at the show secretary table as well as the entrance table near the front door. All exhibitors are also expected to clean up after your dog outside to ensure the grounds are left in proper condition for those who use the arena after our shows have concluded.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

ALL DOGS ENTERED MUST AT LEAST HAVE A TCN. All dogs that are foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering a CKC event requires an Event Registration Number (ERN). The (ERN) does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes but enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. For information on how to obtain an ERN and other temporary numbers, please forward all requests to: The Canadian Kennel Club

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". The banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Policy: FORMS AVAILABLE AT SHOW SECRETARY'S DESK

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being canceled.
- c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

INFORMATION:

- A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- On the day of the show, the show superintendent will be in complete charge of the show which is to be governed by CKC Rules and Regulations. New Rules and regulations apply to these shows and trials.
 - Only dogs properly entered in the show will be admitted.
 - The building will be opened 1 (one) hour before the start of the show.
 - Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging.
 - Dogs **must not** be left in the building overnight.
- Dogs and their handlers should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused from each show when not required for further judging.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitors/handlers to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs is not possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds' conflict. Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the ring steward.

The show committee and the Avalon Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortunes to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

• There are no security services provided at the venue, therefore, property left at the showgrounds is done so at the owner's risk.

o If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is

impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

- We regret that trailer hook ups will not be available at the show site.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official,

a volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities.

The Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. The Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of this action.
 - The show grounds are defined as the confines of The St, John's Recreation Center, St. John's.

There will be zero tolerance of exhibitors not picking up after their dog whether inside or outside of the venue. Supplies will be provided for clean-up

There will be a canteen at the venue. We would appreciate your support of supplies. As well as by purchasing products. This will be a fundraiser for the club. Details to follow in the judging schedule.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINT RATINGS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing (including dog awarded winners) in counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from their ring by the judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

o In no case may a dog earn more than 5 (five) points at a single show. ****

o ****A dog awarded WINNERS that also placed Reserve Best in Show at all all Breed Conformation show shall be credited with four (4) championship points in addition to any points earned at the breed or group level, to the maximum allowed championship points in a single show.

o In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level and under 3 different judges.

o A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points, o Inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

o New changes to Points Calculations with Breed Specialties and Limited Breed shows can garner points as well. Please refer to the new changes to these rules effective January 1, 2023.

CLASSES OFFERED

CONFORMATION

Regular official classes at the CKC championship show shall be as described below:

Junior PuppyDogs 6 (six) months of age and under 9 (nine) months of age on the day of the show. **Senior Puppy**Dogs 9 (nine) months of age and under 12 (twelve) months of age on the day of the

show.

12 - 18 month Dogs 12 (twelve) months of age and under 18 (eighteen) months of age on the day

of the show.

<u>Canadian Bred</u> Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

<u>Open</u> For all dogs

Specials Only Dogs which have recorded a CKC registration or event registration number and have

attained the required points for championship status.

Exhibition OnlyAll dogs entered shall be listed in the catalog with the same particulars as for a dog

entered in competition. This is a non-competition class for dogs over 6 months of age. NOTE Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner of the puppy has also entered a dog in one of the regular classes in the show on that day (these puppies are not entered in any competition and there is no fee, however an entry form must be provided on the date of closing of the entries). These non-competing puppies will not

be listed in the catalog

Non-Regular Classes at this CKC championship show shall be as described below:

** Baby Puppy Class Baby Puppy Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the

show may be entered to compete in this class. An entry form and entry fee are required for this class. These competing puppies will be listed with their respective breeds in the catalog. There is no listing fee applicable for these puppies who do not have their registration number, but if a registration number

has been obtained from CKC it must be indicated on the entry form.

SHOW 1 and 3 ONLY

** Veteran's Class Dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the days of the shows. Dogs may be

spayed or neutered.

Unofficial Classes at this CKC championship show shall be described below:

** Altered Dog Class Dog must be entered as Exhibition only or other regular class. Dogs entered

in this class must be at least 6 months of age or over on the day of the event. Dogs entered in this class must be spayed or neutered by Veterinary procedure.

OBEDIENCE

Pre Novice for all dogs over 6 months of age (Not eligible for High in Trial)

Novice A for dogs handled by the owner or immediate family member for all exercises **Novice B** for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Can. OTCh. degree

or dogs who have earned titles in another country.

Novice C for dogs who have obtained a C.D. title in Canada (Not eligible for High in Trial)

Novice to intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada. (Not

eligible for High in Trial)

Open (HA & 18A) No dog may be entered in more than one OPEN class at one trial

(HA &18A). For dogs that have earned a C.D. in Canada but has not earned a

title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co

owner or a member of the immediate family.

Open (HB & 18B) For dogs who have earned a CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may

be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in either the Open HB or Open 18B class. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility class are also eligible for entry in one of

these classes.

Utility AFor dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D. in CanadaUtility BFor dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in CanadaEXHIBITION ONLYDogs 6 months and over, with a TCN, not in competition.

A Bitch in Estrus (season) may not compete in Obedience Trials.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

Novice A For dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and are

handled by the owner or immediate family member.

Novice B For any dog until a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.

Intermediate For dogs that have earned the RN title.

Advanced A For dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and

are handled by the owner or an immediate family member.

Advanced B For any dog that has earned the RN title.

Excellent A For dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and

are handled by the owner or an immediate family member.

Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title. **Master** For any dog that has earned the RE title.

Ring Size 40 X 50

A Bitch in Estrus (season) may not compete in RALLY OBEDIENCE Trials.

The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems

fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7) No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.
