Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

- 5. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.
- 6. TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 7. DIANA EDWARDS SHOW SERVICES, reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to C.K.C.Dog Show Rules.
- 8. Acknowledgement of Entry and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- 9. 
