**NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

### POINTS

**Champion & Championship Points ~ Chapter 1 Section 1** ~ A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

#### Section 2:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation of Championship points.**

### DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event. The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out". The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

### PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW

The precincts of the Show and Trials will be the entire building. **HKC is hosting this event and we will follow their rules for the show.**

### JUDGING SCHEDULES

Judging Schedules and receipt of entries, armband numbers will be emailed to all entrants. Schedule will be posted on the "CANUCK DOG" website at [www.canuckdogs.com](http://www.canuckdogs.com)

Instructions to getting to the show site are to be found at the end of the Judging Schedule.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Maritime Toy Dog Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
2. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control over their children while they are on the show premises.
3. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these Shows and Trials.
4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)
5. No person may approach a judge directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules)
6. "Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the building.
7. The building will close one and one half hours after the completion of daily judging.
8. Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be allowed in the building.
9. "Puppy for Sale" and "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
10. The Maritime Toy Dog Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
