- 2. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show / Trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 3. The Show / Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, loss or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during theses Show / Trials.
- 5. The owner of a dog entered in these Show / Trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- Dogs entered in the OPEN CLASS must have a CKC Individual Registration Number, a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN), or for Miscellaneous breeds a CKC Certification Number.
