Attention U.S.A. Exhibitors - Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. If you send a cheque it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and any other applicable fees. No exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

Border Crossing - A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate which must be dated at least 30 days prior to entering Canada.

E.R.N. Numbers - The cost of obtaining an Event Registration Number (ERN) with the CKC has been increased to \$58.50 plus 12% HST Canadian funds. To obtain an ERN, send a copy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN. Include payment in full. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or Mastercard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining awards or qualifying scores to avoid cancellation.

PEN Numbers - The cost of obtaining a Performance Event Number (PEN) is \$53.10 plus 12% HST. The PEN allows an unregisterable dog of CKC recognized breed to participate in those competitive events appropriate to the breed. A completed PEN application form must be submitted to CKC whereupon after completing documentation CKC will assign a PEN number.

BITCHES IN SEASON - Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. "When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The trial giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee. The refund and the terms thereof must be clearly stated in the premium list

All exhibitors are required to be familiar with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2012.

Obedience Classes: Regular

Pre Novice, Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Open A, Open B, Utility A and Utility B

Refer to Sections 9 to 13 of the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for full details.

Obedience Classes: Unofficial

Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, Team, Brace and Veterans

Refer to Section 16 of the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for full details.

Dogs entered in Unofficial Classes must also be entered in any regular class or for Exhibition Only.

EXHIBITION ONLY: This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only which must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any Regular class, however it may be entered in and compete in any Unofficial Class . A listing fee is not required for a listed dog entered in Exhibition Only (not entered for any competition).

RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the trial. The trial chairperson shall have full control of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.

. Any dog excused by the chairperson or veterinarian for any reason, shall not, after being excused compete in any class for any award the balance of the trial.

3. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability for, either dogs, exhibitors or patrons in the event of an accident or misfortune.

4. Dogs must be on the grounds one hour prior to the judging of their respective class.

5. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.

6. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.

7. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in the show building.

8. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, if it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there is no refund of entry.

9. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the grounds with the exception of the obedience and rally rings.

PRECINCTS OF THESE TRIALS WILL BE THE AREA INSIDE THE BARN OR OUTSIDE IN THE LARGE FENCED AREA OR ANY OTHER AREA DESIGNATED BY THE CLUB

The following regular CKC Rally classes (not divided by sex) will be provided for purebred dogs of any breed and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous class breeds and of either sex. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B or Advanced A and Advanced B or Excellent A and Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY NOVICE A: 9.1.1 Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Please see 9.1.2 in the Rally Obedience Rule Book which states in part ... No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

RALLY NOVICE B: 9.2.1 Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. 9.3 All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED A: 10.1.1 This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Please see 10.1.2 in the Rally Obedience Rule Book which states in part ...No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY ADVANCED B: 10.2.1 This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. 10.3 All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. **RALLY EXCELLENT A:** 11.1.1 This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Please see 11.1.2 in the Rally Obedience Rule Book which states in part...No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. 11.3 All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
