ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS

We ask that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in CANADIAN FUNDS. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in U.S. funds for the full amount of the entry. **DISCOUNTED CHEQUES OR MONEY ORDERS WILL NOT BE HONOURED.** Please do not send personal cheques marked "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At par". Your cooperation is appreciated.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

APPLIES ONLY TO DOGS WHOLLY OWNED BY A NON CKC MEMBER AND ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CKC MEMBERS

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

ERN

Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example: AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.

The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellations of any wins, awards, and scores.

GENERAL INFORMATION/SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1. The show building will be open Wednesday evening from 6 pm to 10 pm, and at 7 am until 10 pm each day of the show.
- 2. All entries must be complete, including the full name & address of the owner of the dog. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how and by whom entries were made. Changes or cancellations after closing date are prohibited except according to CKC rules.
- 3. An exhibitor entering puppies 4 to 6 months of age may not enter more than two of that age.
- 4. **No refund of entry fee will be made** if, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Wheat City Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show.
- 5. The Wheat City Kennel Club will use due care & diligence to ensure the welfare and safety of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors, or spectators. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs left in the building at owners' risk. There will be **no watchman** hired by WCKC on duty at night in the show and kennel area.
- 6. Dogs must be in the show building at least one hour prior to the judging of their breed. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to have their dog(s) at ringside when required for judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. ONLY DOGS ENTERED IN THE SHOW/TRIAL ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.
- 7. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the shows and trials.
- 8. Wheat City Kennel Club is **not** be responsible for contracts made with the show photographer
- 9. Exhibitors <u>must exercise their dogs in the designated areas provided</u> Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. No private exercise pens will be allowed without permission from the show superintendent
- 10. All dogs classed as "In Transit" must be identified to the Show Secretary before the start of the first show.
- 11. There will be no practicing in the obedience/rally ring at any time. Any exhibitor that enters this ring other than during the actual trial can be subject to disciplinary action.
- 12. Any dog found in the building that has not been entered in a regular class or for Exhibition only prior to closing will be charged \$30. per Day for Exhibition fees.

THE KEYSTONE CENTRE IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY. PLEASE ABIDE BY THIS PROVINCIAL LAW.

There are smoking areas outside the building.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded *Winners* at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded. **Winners** shall be as follows.

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded *Winners* also places in the **GROUP** as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show.** For a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

<u>Best Puppy in Breed</u> – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is <u>NOT</u> required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

Dogs Competing 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 & more Points Allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5

(b) The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at Group level for all levels of GCh: Number of Dog Competing at Group Level

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each.

Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20** of the **Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show,** by the owner or handler.

Effective January 2022: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration number **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the CKC registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a **TCN** dog. TCN fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded.**

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)
