## **Judging Schedule and General Information**

\*\*\*all times listed are for Eastern Daylight time\*\*\*

Unloading and loading of show equipment for setup and take down, will be at the far entrance to the arena when entering the grounds from Victoria Avenue. (The large Zamboni door) It will be enforced that you drop off your equipment on the grass nearest the road, trolleys will be made available, and then go park your vehicle. There will be members assigned to watch your personal items while you park. You will not be able to drive directly up to the door. For walk in service, there is a doorway at the south end of the arena nearest the track. There are 3 doors to maneuver, but access is available from that end of the arena.

### **Building Hours and Set-up Times**

The show building will be open for exhibitor set-up at 4pm-9pm Thursday September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The building will be open at 7:30 am on Friday, 8:00 am Saturday and Sunday

The building will close at 5 pm each night.

The building hours are set by the hiring of city staff to have the facility open, so these hours will be strictly enforced and there will be no exceptions.

No dogs are to be left in the building overnight.

Please note that no dogs are allowed behind the boards.

Exercise pens will only be allowed in the reserved grooming areas.

In the unreserved grooming areas, as we are restricted in space, exhibitors may be asked to remove extra items like chairs, etc. if we need to squeeze in additional exhibitors.

#### Parking

There is a gravel parking lot to the left of the arena when approaching from Victoria Avenue. There is a paved parking lot next to the arena and track. Both of which we may use. There is also roadside parking throughout the park. Please watch as some of the ditches are deep. Do not park on the grass areas not designated for parking. Some of the areas have drainage issues, so please stay to the designated surfaces.

Motor homes should park in the gravel parking lot. Please park perpendicular to the side fence rails so that everyone involved in the show will have ample parking.

**Power is also limited**, so please share with your neighbours.

Remember that kitchen items & heaters may not be plugged in!! They blow the breakers!! Please do not bring wet dogs to dry at the arena.

The power will be specifically designated for the paid reserved grooming in a priority basis, ie: as received. Exhibitors are responsible to bring their own extension cords.

The arena canteen is closed, but we will have a refreshment service, Northern Unique, during the show hours each day. The caterer makes a lovely donation to the Junior Handling fund, so please support the Juniors with their sales. There will be free coffee each morning, please help yourself.

Arm bands can be picked up at the Show Secretary's table and will be used for the entire weekend.

This is a non-smoking/vaping recreational property. Please use the appropriate disposal of butts, do not throw them on the ground for dogs to step on or eat!

**Ontario Smoking Law** 

It is illegal to smoke or vape on and within 20 meters of children's playgrounds and publicly owned sport fields and surfaces (e.g., areas for basketball, baseball, soccer or beach volleyball, ice rinks, tennis courts, splash pads and swimming pools that are owned by a municipality, the province or a postsecondary education institution)

Remember this is a Self-cleaning show, indoors and out. If your dog messes in the ring, the ring steward will be happy to hold your dog, while YOU clean up. Cleaning supplies, baggies for outdoors, will be available in the ready ring. There will be poop bags and garbage cans available outdoors for your use. Please help us keep the surrounding grounds clean. Remember this facility is in a public park frequented by many, so please be diligent with your pickup. Do not allow your dogs to relieve themselves on the building.

There will be no on-site bathing of dogs. There are multiple dog wash areas in the vicinity of the arena.

Do not forget Grace's closet, they always have a lovely variety of show clothes both for the juniors and adults alike.

The club is looking forward to a great show. We have a good entry and I know we can all welcome new exhibitors and out of town guests. Although there may be issues that arise, there is no problem that cannot be solved. Be courteous to all, and if you need assistance come to the show secretary's table. New club members are covering some positions they are unfamiliar with, so please be patient.

I hope I have not made errors in the judging schedule, but if you notice something, do not panic!!! Just email me and I will check your entries. Those little boxes do a number on my old eyes after a while. Please specify your name, email address and the dog's name so I have a reference to look items up. I honestly do not remember everyone's "special 4-legged sweetie" and their name and class, but I am always happy to help.
