

CONFORMATION

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:
Baby Puppy a dog 3 months up to 6 months of the day of the show (does not compete for points)

Junior puppy a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior puppy a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show
12-15 Month a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show
15-18 Month a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show
Canadian bred a dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by exhibitor a dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open class all dogs "all dogs divided by colour"
Veterans a dog 7 years and over
Specials only dogs who are Canadian champions only
Exhibition dogs 6 months and over, not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Altered Classes: Offered for spayed and neutered dogs over 6 months of age to compete for Winners Male and Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes. Offered for the National Specialty only on Sept. 01, 2016

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (offered for the National Specialty only on Sept. 01, 2016)

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class shall be for Stud Dog and two or more of his Get.
Brood Bitch Class shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny.
Brace Class shall be for 2 dogs of the same colour of either sex and identical ownership.
Parade of Titleholders is open to all CKC recognized titleholders.
Best Canadian Bred in Specialty will be offered at this Specialty.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. Conformation and Sweeps entries may be made on the same form.

There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class - for Cavaliers at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
Senior Class - for Cavaliers at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
12-18 Open - for Cavaliers at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

For Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

5% of the pot will go to the winner of each class.

2% of the pot will go to the second in class.

20% of the pot will go to the Best in Sweeps.

15% of the pot will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

23% of the pot will be retained for administrative purposes.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B (Pre-Novice, Novice C and Novice Intermediate) SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights

Pre-Novice for all purebred dogs over 6 months of age. (Not eligible for HIT Competition)
"A" Classes for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises.
"B" Classes for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Can. OTCh. degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.
"C" Classes for dogs who have completed a C.D. title in Canada. (Not eligible for H.I.T. competition)
C.D.I. Class Novice-Intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada (Not eligible for H.I.T. Competition)
Open for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada.
Utility A for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D. in Canada.
Utility B for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada
Exhibition Dogs 6 months & over, not in competition.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL TROPHY LIST

Trophy and Rosette for first place in Novice A, Novice B, Open A, Open B & Utility A, Utility B in each Trial. High in Trial, trophy & rosette offered. Combined Award (Obedience & Conformation).

Please Note: Perpetual trophies won by non-members of the Club will be held by the Club and engraved with the name of the winner. N.B: *All members that have won a trophy & do not claim it, a \$15.00 handling charge plus engraving costs will be applied.*

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

Novice A-For dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Novice B-For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.
Advance Int.-Elective class. For dogs that have earned the RN title.
Advanced A-For dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Advanced B-For any dog that has earned the RN title.
Excellent A for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Excellent B For any dog that has earned the RA title.

A Bitch in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian's Certificate.

Trophy and Rosette for first place in Novice A, Novice B, Advanced A, Advanced B & Excellent A , Excellent B in each Trial.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW TROPHY LIST

Perpetual Trophies, keeper trophies & rosettes will be offered for: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Puppy in Breed, Best of Winners, Winners Male, Winners Female, Res. Winners Male, Res. Winners Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed 1st in each class, Brace, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Best Can. Bred in Breed, Best Bred By Exhibit in Specialty.
A Perpetual Trophy is offered for the dog achieving the highest obedience score & highest conformation placing from an official class at the Specialty Show - combined. Points will be determined by using the score obtained in obedience (must be qualifying score in both conformation and obedience) plus 50 points for Best of Breed (Best Puppy); 40 points for Best of Opposite; 30 points for Best of Winners; 25 points for Award of Merit; 25 points for Winners Dog/Bitch; 20 points for Reserve Winners; 10 points for class first & 5 points for class win placing other than first. In the case of a tie, the highest Obedience score will decide the winner.

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show and hotel grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling. Failure to do so shall give the CKCSCC Board of Directors the power to take such action as it deems fit toward the owner of such dog. Exhibitors failing to comply with this rule may be refused entry at future specialties
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Canada will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you
A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
- Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$50.00 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.
