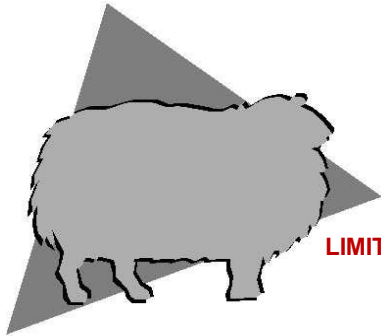

**No post-dated cheques accepted.** All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trials.

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

**PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR OBEDIENCE AND RALLY OBEDIENCE**

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Obedience & Rally Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

**The precincts of the trials shall be the building and its entrances.**

## ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS:

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs who are owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. ### NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found online at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Trial Committee will be in full charge of trials which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. All exhibitors will be held responsible for cleanup on the trial grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.

3. The MG7 Club and the Maritime Opportunity Centre will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
4. A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
5. No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
6. "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
7. The MG7 Club and the Trials Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons.
8. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MG7 Club and its Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or close the trials, no refund of entries will be made.
9. All rules and regulations as outlined in the Maritime Group 7 Club Premium List apply to this event.
10. **Bitches in season** shall not be eligible to enter the trial (please see refunds/duplicate entries - #11 General Information)..
11. **There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments:** Entry Fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in the Trials comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial.
12. Rally Ring Size will be 40' x 50'.

#### NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non-member of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number. To protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled. Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

#### TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN) – Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. The TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Competition Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN. There is no fee to obtain a TCN, however, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN. TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where

the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC Events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. Effective January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian Registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian-born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, with a written request for an ERN and including full payment. Accounts may be paid with a personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For non-members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address, faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your Visa/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 3-day extension. Please forward your request to:
