## **Classifications (Both Specialities)**

The following classes (divided by sex) are offered:  
All regular classes as indicated in the Lakehead Kennel Club Premium List:  
(i.e. Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12 – 18 Mo, Bred By, Canadian Bred, Open, Specials) &  
Exhibition Only plus Baby Puppy Classes

### **Baby Puppy Class**

The Baby Puppy Class is for dogs 3 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy Class do not compete for points.  
Puppies entered in this class will participate & compete for Best Baby Puppy in Specialty.  
NB...There is NO LISTING FEE for Baby Puppies who are not yet registered!!!!

### **Plus**

**Veterans Class**                      For dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. (Dogs entered in this class may be neutered/spayed). Classes further divided by age (7-10 and 11 & over). Best Veteran Male & Female will compete for Breed.

**Altered Classes**                      All dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

### **Non-Regular Classes**

**\*\*All dogs entered in the non-regular classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in Exhibition Only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.**

**Brace:**                                  Two dogs shown on a single lead. **Ownership does NOT have to be identical.**  
**Team:**                                  Four dogs shown on a single lead. **Ownership does NOT have to be identical.**  
**Stud Dog:**                              A dog and at least two of his get. (Breeders/Owners **need NOT** be identical)  
**Brood Bitch:**                            A bitch and at least two of her progeny. (Breeders/Owners **need NOT** be identical)

## **(Siberian Husky Club of Canada – Saturday Only)**

All dogs entered in these classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in Exhibition Only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

### **WORKING DOG CLASSES**

Two classes to be offered at the SHCC specialty for dogs who have obtained their SHCC WD or WDX certificate. A copy of the title certificate must accompany all entries. Males & Females to be judged together. Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> positions, the 2 winners (best WD & WDX) will compete for Best overall Working Dog.

### **SLED DOG CLASSES (proof of title to accompany entries)**

3 classes (SD,SDX, SDU) Males & Females judged together  
Winner of each class compete for Best Overall Sled Dog.

### **PUPPY SWEEPS**

Classes (divided by sex) are: 6-9 Mo; 9-12 M0; 12 – 18 Mo  
All dogs must be entered in the Specialty or in Exhibition Only; Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

**Prizes:** Trophy & Rosette for Best In Sweeps; Rosette for Best of Opposite in Sweeps  
1<sup>st</sup> in each class – 30% of entries for that class; 2<sup>nd</sup> in class – 20% of entries for that class  
3<sup>rd</sup> in each class – 15% of entries for that class; 4<sup>th</sup> in class – 10% of entries for that class  
(25% to be retained by the Club)

### SLED DOG CLASSES:

\*\*\* For all purebred registered Siberian Huskies \*\*All dogs entered in the non-regular classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in Exhibition Only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

**Class A:** For dogs with any level of "Sled Dog" titles (SD;SDX;SDU – Canadian and American titles accepted)

**Class B:** For dogs who have completed a publicized race\* greater than 20km.

**Class C:** For dogs who have completed a publicized race\* less than 20km.

(NB: Class B & C entries will require a copy of documentation signed by race official.)

On Sunday, at the Amethyst Siberian Husky Club Specialty, the winners of each sled dog class will compete for Best Overall Sled Dog, and The Henry Csabak Memorial Trophy.

\* publicized race means any race that has been announced in a recognized magazine/newsletter or website, such as Sleddog Central, Team & Trail etc.

### Junior Handling in each Specialty

A regular junior handling competition will be held in conjunction with the specialty. Juniors *MUST* handle a Siberian Husky, and may sign up at the Show.
