Grooming Space

Grooming will only be allowed on areas tarped by the NKC, crates should be placed along the perimeters and grooming tables must be placed a minimum of 3 feet from the edge of the tarped area. This will help protect the floors from overspray. There is to be no spraying of any kind ringside/in any un-tarped areas. Please keep marked aisles clear.

In addition, as always you must bring your own floor covering for your set-ups. All exhibitors must cover the floor of their grooming area. Plastic, paper or fabric material which may be secured with painter's tape. (Duct tape is NOT permissible.) The floors have recently been replaced and there is a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for grooming on uncovered space.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par." They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated. Thank You.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event).
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

* Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Championship Point Ratings

A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* Includes the dog awarded winners.

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All-Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion it must win at least 10 points under 3 different judges, which includes at least one 2-point win.

CORRECTING SHOW RESULTS – NEW FOR 2024

Section 9.9 The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations: The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Moving Class Dog to Specials Only Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to “Specials Only,” providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler. When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

Moving from Specials Back to the Classes Section 8.10.5 A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.

General Information

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Newfoundland All Breed Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
3. Only dogs entered in the show will be allowed in the building.
4. All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the show site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the show grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year. NKC has a zero-tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike conduct during and in relation to their events, including on social media.
5. The use of flexi leads, prong, spike, or electronic collars is prohibited on show grounds.
6. *Rocky Brook Photography will be on-site as our official show photographer! Please note that the photographers set up is exclusively for use by Rocky Brook Photography and may not be used by exhibitors for personal photos or candids.

7. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
8. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds' conflict.
9. Judging will commence at 9 a.m. each day. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule. The building will open at 8:00 a.m. each morning & close 30 minutes after completion of Saturday judging.
10. Building will be open at 7pm Friday evening for set-up. There will be absolutely no exhibitor access to the building prior to 7pm Friday evening.
11. Exhibitors MUST vacate the premises one hour after the judging of General Specials on Sunday.
12. SHOW PRECINCTS: Show precincts shall consist of the entire arena. NOTE: The Show Superintendent may restrict the placing of chairs, tables and crates and may limit the use of private exercise pens during show hours.
