JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES Sunday August 4, 2024. Lunch Break

Judge (all classes):

Classes will be divided by Sex and Age:

4-6 months / 6–9 months / 9–12 months / 12–18 months

Rosettes will be awarded to First in each class, Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-up. Flat ribbons will be awarded to 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each class. Class winners will also receive 5% of total entry fee. Best in Sweepstakes will receive a 20% of total entry fees collected, Runner-up 15% of total fees collected. Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-up will be chosen from the Class winners. Remainder 25% will be retained by the Club to defray costs. To enter sweepstakes, the dog must be entered in one of the regular/non-regular classes or in Exhibition Only on Saturday August 5, 2023.

Veterans Saturday August 3 2024

Judge (all classes):

The classes will be separated **by sex and age**. Age classes will be 7 years – 10 years and over 10 years of age. Altered dogs are welcome. Rosettes will be offered for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-up. A rosette will be offered for First in each class and flats for 2-4th place. The winner of Best in Sweepstakes will receive 50% of the entry and the Runner-up will receive 25% of the entry. Remainder 25% will be retained by the club to defray costs.

JUNIOR HANDLING: Saturday August 3 & Sunday August 4 at lunch break

Judge (all classes): T.B.A.

There will be a \$2.00 fee which will be collected at the show. Any dog entered in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or for exhibition only in the show that day. The dog need <u>not</u> be owned by the Junior Handler or any of his immediate family.

CLASSES (Subject to CKC Rules)

Peewee (unofficial Class), Junior Novice, Intermediate Novice, Senior Novice, Intermediate Open, Junior Open, Senior Open Rosettes will be awarded for Best Overall Junior Handler and for First Place in Each Class (excluding the non- competitive Pee Wee class). A Flat Ribbon will be awarded for Second through Fourth in Each Class. A Participant Ribbon will be awarded to each Pee Wee Class Exhibitor.

CLASSIFICATION - CONFORMATION

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show.

<u>12-18 MONTH CLASS</u> - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

<u>CANADIAN BRED</u> - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled

in the ring by the breeder

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY – Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs **4 months** of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for these classes are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

VETERANS CLASSES - This class is for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

CLASSIFICATION - RALLY OBEDIENCE

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial. **RALLY NOVICE B** - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

RALLY INTERMEDIATE – The Rally Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Rally Advanced classes. This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RI or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs may be entered in this class as a regular entry or changed to it from another official class within the same trial. The request to change must be made on the appropriate CKC form and be submitted to the trial secretary at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the trial.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RN title but have not earned the RA title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RN title. A dog completing the RA title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the RA title but have not earned the RE title or any CKC obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RA title. A dog completing the RE title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY MASTER - This class will be for dogs that have earned the RE title. A dog completing the RM title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

CLASSIFICATION – OBEDIENCE

PRE-NOVICE - The Pre-Novice class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of PCD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all five exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when

they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of CD may enter the Pre-Novice class.

NOVICE A - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under Section 10.1.4. No person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

NOVICE B - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of CD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

NOVICE C - The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

OPEN HA & OPEN 18A - The Open A classes shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD but has not earned the title of CDX. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in these classes and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle a dog in these classes. When a dog is wrongfully entered in these classes, any score awarded will be cancelled. No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial.

OPEN HB & OPEN 18B - The Open B classes shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CD. Dogs that have earned the title of CDX or any higher obedience titles may enter either of the Open B classes. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. Dogs in these classes may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in these classes. The same handler must handle each dog in all seven exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such case, they must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise(s). Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed for Open HB and Open 18B. These choices will not be disclosed to exhibitors until they are posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of each class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines, so they will be used approximately the same number of times. No dog may be entered in more than one Open class at any one trial.

UTILITY A - The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX but has not earned the title of UD. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCH title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

UTILITY B - The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title of CDX or UD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class and never more than one hour before the start of the trial.

EXHIBITION ONLY - This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only, which is an official class that must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any regular class; however, it may be entered in and compete in any unofficial class or parade offered at the trial on payment of the prescribed fees

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Gates open 12:00 PM Friday – August 2, 2024. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!! Spots will be pre-assigned, but if you choose to come at 12 PM be prepared for long waits by bringing water and cooling materials for your dogs with the expectation you may be waiting in line in warmer weather.

NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON OR AROUND SHOW GROUNDS PRIOR TO THIS TIME. Parking must be reserved through <u>dogshow.ca</u> or by submitting a paper form through the mail.

The length of RVs will determine what area you will be assigned to park in as space is limited. You will be directed to your assigned spot by the parking coordinator upon arrival. Spots will be indicated by markers - **do not move any markers or take up extra space in the rear ball diamond.**

Keeping your equipment secure at night is the exhibitors responsibility.

Exhibitors who wish to park together please send an email to the show secretary and efforts will be made to accommodate your wishes but there are no guarantees.

As water availability is not guaranteed exhibitors are recommended to fill up water tanks prior to arriving on site. Please fill up your RVS at the Shell station as you enter town.

RV PARKING FEES

With Power: \$40 per night. Non-reserved parking will be \$60.00 per night- exact cash only.

This is not a secured area! All parking is at the owner's risk.

- All generators must be turned off between 11:00 pm and 6:00 am
- All generators must be on a raised platform away from ignition sources
- Anyone found discharging grey water on the grounds will be removed IMMEDIATELY.
- Please respect our parking volunteers as to their directions. Any argument, abusive language, or uncooperative behavior will not be tolerated and expulsion from the grounds will result, along with future barring of parking at CRDFS events.

NO CLEAN-UP CREW WILL BE PROVIDED. PLEASE ENSURE YOU SCOOP AFTER YOUR DOG. Scoop after your pet by-law is in effect! All camp sites and grooming areas must be clean before you leave the grounds. Please put all garbage in the bins; do not leave garbage at your site. Offenders may lose RV parking privileges next year.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.

2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show. Any female excused because of being in season shall not be allowed to compete in any class for any award.

3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animal's while they are on the show grounds.

6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed.

7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.

8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.

10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.

11. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite, Best of Breed. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further Section 15.1.12{C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed level or group level. "The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed below.

A class Dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) (47-06-12)

- 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship.
- 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship.
- 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
 - a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, and are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are

calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

(d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward

15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.



(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

(a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

(b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.**15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)** (48-06-12)

- 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.
- 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

(a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)

(b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.

(c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty

Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.
