#### **Show Practices**

- Each exhibitor will complete a Waiver of Liability for the German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada Inc. and Wet Noses Inc as part of their entry (either online entry or mailed entry). No one will be allowed to participate who has not completed the required Waiver. If you entered online, please print and bring a copy of your signed Waiver. The Show Secretary will confirm receipt of your signed Waiver before giving out armbands.
- We ask that every person participate in a Self-Assessment for COVID found at <u>www.alberta.ca</u> each day. If you are feeling unwell and/or are exhibiting symptoms of COVID, please stay home.
- 3. Anyone exhibiting COVID symptoms will be asked to leave the show grounds and will not be allowed to return.
- 4. Masks are required during the exam portion only of showing the dog and on the show grounds when social distancing is not possible. Masks are not required any other time in the conformation rings as long as social distancing is maintained.
- 5. Equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day.
