Junior Handling - Any dog may be entered for competition in an ASCA-sanctioned Junior Handling class held at a conformation show. This is an all-breed competition. The intent of the program is that any youth may compete in the ASCA Junior Handling 7 Program with any breed of dog, regardless of whom the dog belongs to. These dogs may be ASCA registered to include intact, altered or LEP, or registered in another registry, or other pure-bred dogs or mixed breeds. In other programs a junior must see the pertinent program rules to determine if their dog is eligible to compete. To earn points toward the ASCA Junior Program year-end awards, however, the dog must be a purebred ASCA Registered Australian Shepherd, (Intact or altered to include LEP & Hardship Registered) and must meet the ownership criteria defined under a separate heading in these rules.
