These rules and SKOC Regulations are subject to change depending on SHA Regulations.

PLEASE do not attend these trials if you are exhibiting any irregular signs of illness.

*Waiver must be signed by every competitor and provided at their mat time or first walk through.

*Masks are mandatory in all areas of the trial precinct

*No Canteen

*No Exhibition Only

*No Spectators

*Catalogues will be provided by Email only

**There is limited access to the building - No Benching Available – only the dog and handler in the ring and on deck will be allowed in the building (subject to change) – only one person at a time at the secretary desk, washroom and ribbon table.

**Please maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet from those not within your household.

**Each exhibitor may bring one person in the building with them to watch/video and hold their jacket and other things.

**Friday night mat time - ten minutes for \$15.00, must be pre-booked and prepaid - 5:30pm to 8:30pm - bookings for mat time will be open to reserve by emailing jerri.mcphee@sasktel.net

Any handler unable to attend these trials due to experiencing COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, after entries close, will receive a credit to any future CKC events hosted by the SKOC. Credits will expire after one year. Entries from this trial will be considered equal value to the credit towards future trial(s).

COVID-19 CKC RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL ALLOWABLE CHANGES

- Five (5) handlers allowed per walk through, in running order.
- ♦ Only the dog and handler in the ring and the dog and handler on deck are allowed in the building (subject to COVID-19 guidelines).
- ♦ For off leash classes, the handler will place their leash in a designated spot and pick it up after their run. The ring steward will NOT bring your leash to you. Your dog must leave the ring on-leash and under control.
- ♦ Armband Numbers will be placed on a chair to be picked up by handlers on your way to the ring for the walk through.
- ♦ Qualifying Rosettes, ribbons and score sheets will be left on a table for handlers to pick up if they wish at end of their class and removed prior to the end of the next class. No ribbon/rosette presentations in the ring.
- ◆ Special prizes will be verified by Trial Chair or Event Secretary and will be placed out at time of award in specified location.
- ◆ There will be no printed catalogues. Electronic Copies may be provided by email.
- Individual printed courses will be available. They may only be picked up on the way to the course walk
