Bob's passion for the Fancy began in 1956 when his neighbors began taking him to dog shows. His first dog, a Bedlington Terrier, was winners dog at the old Morris and Essex Kennel Club show almost sixty years ago. The puppy was nine months old and the entry was eighty! What a wonderful start to a life time adventure. As time went on through the teen years Bob finished many of his own dogs and those of friends, as well. As a young adult he handled professionally and enjoyed many successes with mainly Sight Hounds, Terriers, Toys, and Non-Sporting breeds. In 1968 he became quite taken with Dandie Dinmonts when he met Nancy Mann of the very well known Woodbourne Kennel.

Over time he also operated a large boarding kennel and owned and operated two grooming shops. Being a member of The Bedlington Terrier Club of America since 1959 he has had many positions within the club, including President, Director, and Show Chairman. He is also a life member of The Louisville Kennel Club and a director of The Dandie Dinmont Terrier Club of America.

As a judge he travels extensively throughout North America and has visited at least ten foreign countries. He is especially pleased with having judged Specialty Shows in nearly forty different breeds, many of the breeds several times, and considers this the best compliment one could receive.

Paul has been an animal advocate and dedicated dog owner all his life. He has had various mixed breeds, beagles and shelties prior to settling on his breed of choice, the Irish Water Spaniel (IWS). Paul is an avid upland and waterfowl hunter and loves to work his dogs in the field and enjoys rally and regular obedience. Paul loves dogs of all breeds (especially puppies and veterans), enjoys ring stewarding and competing in conformation, in rally and regular obedience and in working certificate and hunt tests in venues provided by the CKC, AKC, UKC and NAHRA (where he is a life member).

Paul encountered his first IWS in the early 1970's when, as a teenager, a British army officer attending the Royal Military Staff College in Kingston moved into his acreage community with 2 IWS. It was love at first sight and he swore that one day he would have an IWS. After graduating university, he moved

west to Calgary with his sheltie Kailin by his side to work as a petroleum exploration geologist. He then convinced his friend and now wife, Paula, to join him in Calgary. When their much-loved sheltie Kailin passed at 15 years old, they felt it was time to get another dog and started the search for an IWS. It took over 2 years to find the right one but it was one special dog, "Mr. Red" aka Torin (MBIS/BISS Can GrCh/Amer/Fin/Est Ch Mystic Torin CD RN WC). Torin compiled CKC, AKC and international win record that after more than 15 years still have not been surpassed. Further his sons, daughters, grandsons, granddaughters and now great-grandsons and great granddaughters are continuing his winning legacy around the world. Paul continues to breed numerous top winning IWS at the CKC, AKC and international Breed, Group and Best in Show levels (BIS/BISS/BPIS) under his CKC registered kennel name Coomara. He is active in local dog clubs and the CKC (a former registration committee and discipling committee member). He continues to breed numerous top work and the member.

registration committee and discipline committee member). He continues to breed and hunt his IWS, act as strong voice for responsible dog ownership and for protecting pure bred dogs and is now working towards becoming a licensed CKC conformation judge.
