REGULAR FEES . All regular classes \$25. All non-regular classes including Baby Puppy \$10, all sweeps \$10, All Parades \$10. Enter online at dogshow.ca

SWEEPSTAKE CLASSES - ALL DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN THE SPECIALTY OR IN EXHIBITION ONLY.

Puppy Sweeps - Classes (divided by sex) are 6-9 mos, 9-12 mos, 12-18 mos. Veteran Sweeps - Classes (divided by sex) are 7 to 10 years & over 10 years. Sled Dog Sweeps - Dogs must be over 12 mos of age. Males & females judged together. A Best in Sweeps & BOS in Sweeps will be awarded. Sled dog titles are not required but proof that the dog has run in harness must accompany the entry (ie. Passport or complete Sled Dog Sweepstakes Specialty Entry Form on the back of the premium list)

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

TCNs allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while pursuing permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN) (if foreign).

Reminder: All unregistered recognized breeds must obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering an event.

This includes Baby Puppies. TCNs replaced the previous system of entering dogs into events as "listed". Only 1 TCN is required for each dog and must be used for all event entries until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. Dogs exempt from obtaining a TCN include Listed Breeds that require a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN), dogs that require a Performance Event Number (PEN), and dogs that require a Canine Companion Number (CCN) before entering into an event.

***** JUNIOR HANDLING ***** .

Juniors MUST pre-enter. Make sure the dog you are using is entered in Jr Handling by having the box ticked on their entry form. CKC Junior Handling rules apply. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only.

*****BABY PUPPY CLASS*****

The Baby Puppy Class is for dogs 4 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy Class do not compete for points.

Puppies entered in this class will participate & compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Group , & Show. TCN are required for baby puppies to be entered.

Classifications - In all breeds, recognized by the C.K.C., the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex.

Junior Puppy - 6 Months and under 9 Months on day of show.

Senior Puppy - 9 Months and under 12 Months on day of show.

12 – 18 Months - 12 Months and under 18 Months on day of show.

Canadian Bred Dogs - born in Canada (Champions of any country excluded)

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs - owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

- **Open For all dogs**
- **Specials Only For Canadian Champions**

Exhibition Only - For dogs over 4 Months of age, eligible for registration with the CKC Note: In all breeds, where classes are divided by colour, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class division on the entry forms.

The following classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

Veterans Class - For dogs 7 years of age & over on the day of the show (dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered).

Altered Class - All dogs over 6 mos of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

NON- REGULAR CLASSES:

All dogs entered in non-regular classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

Brace/Team - Two /Four dogs shown on a single lead. .

Stud Dog: A dog & at least 2 of his get, ownership need not be the same.

Brood Bitch: A bitch & at least 2 of her progeny, owners need not be the same.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Working Dog Class (WD,WDX) & Sled Dog Class (SD, SDX, SDU) : Both sexes judged together, proof of title to accompany entry. Best Overall in each title will be awarded.

PRIZES AND ROSETTES WILL BE OFFERED FOR THE FOLLOWING: 1st place in each class through to Best of Breed, Award of Merit may be awarded at the discretion of the judge (1 award for each 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed), Best Bred By (selected from the winners of the Bred By Classes), Best Veteran, BOS Veteran, Best of Breed (Altered), Best of Opposite Sex (Altered), Best Brace, Best Team, Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Bitch, Best Overall & BOS Sled Dog, Best Overall & BOS Working Dog. PERPETUAL TROPHIES: Best of Breed - The W. B. Screaton Challenge Cup donated by W.B. Screaton, Best Overall Sled Dog Trophy donated by M.P. McCoy, Best Overall Working Dog donated by SHCC & Best Bred By donated by Diane Solman/ Manon Parent, chosen from the winners of the Bred By classes.. All Perpetual trophies remain in the possession of the SHCC, a keeper trophy will be awarded

VETERANS, SLED DOG & PUPPY SWEEPS: \$50 & rosette for Best in Sweeps, \$25 & rosette BOS in Sweeps.

JUNIOR HANDLING - all regular classes in Jr Handling are offered as part of the specialty. Juniors must handle a Siberian Husky and must pre register on the dogs entry.

PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS: Open to all dogs that have been awarded a conformation or performance event title. Rosette

Notice To All Foreign Exhibitors

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. events will no longer require a C.K.C. registration number, but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN does not register a dog with the C.K.C. for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the C.K.C. Each dog must have its own number. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request to the CKC for an extension.

Notice To All Canadian Residents Only

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Chapter 20: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing	* 1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more

Section 4. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.
