## OUR JUDGES

#### David Swartwood

He was raised with and training dogs for his entire life starting Boston Terriers. Later he bred American Cockers, followed by Lhasa Apsos and finally deciding on English Springers Spaniels (Bryden Reg'd) as his breed of choice over 32 years ago. These dogs have achieved International fame in conformation, obedience, agility, rally, tracking, therapy and even hunt tests but mostly as loved family pets. They also have been top in the breed and within top ten sporting dogs on many occasions and BISS x3 at the English Springer Spaniel Club of Canada Nationals. After 20 years as an all-breed handler, David enjoys judging and raising Miniature Wire Hair Dachshunds under the "Prelude" prefix with his partner Tom Nesbitt. They also run a training school and small farm with sheep, goats, donkeys, llamas and a wide variety of poultry, turkeys, chickens, guinea hens, quail and peacocks.

#### Thomas Edward Nesbitt

He bought his first show dog, a Siberian Husky, in 1968, then bought an American Cocker in 1982. In 1993, his partner David Swartwood, moved to Canada and introduced him to the wonderful world of English Springers. They launched themselves into miniature wire-haired dachshunds. In 1994 he began his judging career and is now licensed as a Canadian Kennel Club all-breed judge. He is a theologian by training, having graduated McGill University in Montreal. His career was in palliative health care and was also the National Executive Director of Canadian Guide Dogs for the Blind. Retired now, he has had the privilege of judging across Canada, the USA, the Bahamas, Bermuda, Japan, Mexico, New Zealand, Australia, Colombia and Costa Rica.

### Steve Dainard

Steve comes from a second generation dog show family and began showing dogs in his early teens in the late seventies, starting with Flat Coated Retrievers and later with English Springer Spaniels. With his wife Kelly, they breed English Springer Spaniels under the 'KAS' prefix, achieving the top winning male in Canadian history and number one all breeds. He also owned at the time shown, the breed's top winning/producing sire in the U.S.A and has also owned top winning Australian Shepherds. A former all-breed handler, Steve has judged in Canada, the U.S.A., Australia, and Colombia. In his professional life he is a financial and administrative manager with the Toronto Transit Commission.

### Joe Lobb

Joe Lobb got his first dog, a Doberman, in 1974. With his wife Janet, he bred our first litter in 1977 under the 'Dobehaus' prefix and in 1988, he added the Smooth Fox Terriers which he continues to breed and exhibit on a limited basis under the "FauxPaw" prefix. They also handled professionally on a limited basis. As well as Dobermans and Smooth Fox Joe has also owned and exhibited German Shepherds, Bernese Mountain Dog, Bouvier, Greyhound and Black & Tan Coonhounds. In addition to Canada, he has judged in Australia, the USA and China as well as at 'rare breed' events. In his other life, Joe is a sales manager for a major tractor manufacturer.

### Michelle Scott

Michelle Scott is a former all-breed handler, who bred Lakeland Terriers for many years, and is now a Standard Poodle breeder under the kennel name Brielle. She has judged poodle specialties in Canada, the US, and Denmark. She has also judged in Australia and Colombia.

## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

## SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Email and Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.
3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT accepted. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **A \$25.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.**
4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but **MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING** to the Show Secretary so as to be received no more than 7 days after closing.
6. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
7. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed or emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address. All online and fax entries will receive a conformation email, this is your receipt for our shows. Please print your email address clearly.
8. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
9. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show Giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
10. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
11. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
12. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. **Anyone not following stop and scoop policy will be excused from the shows and trials.**

### **Non-Member Participation Fee**

#### **24-12-3. Non-member participation fee**

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

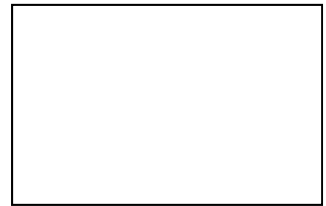
