A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online, by fax or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

6.1 Entry Requirements

6.1.1 Draft dog tests shall be open to all dogs of sufficient height and weight that are physically capable of performing all the exercises in a particular class. The judges must excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity. All dogs must be 18 months of age or over on the first day.

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Friday, September 16, 2022 (10:00 p.m. CST) or when the limit it reached

When the limit is reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position (by test) on the alternate list to be drawn up in the same order as the receipt of entries. The person making the entry shall be notified of his position on the list. In the event any dog is pulled after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the alternate list up to and including the day of the tests. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the test for those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test.

"DAY OF TEST" ENTRIES

Day of test entries will be accepted on the days of the test, on a first come, first serve basis, beginning 90 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of each trial and ending 60 minutes prior to the start time or when the limit of 24 teams has been reached.


Canteen, Food & Camping Info
