Rules of the Show

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any persons from the Show / Trials. The Show / Trial Superintendent shall have full control of the event which will be governed by Canadian Kennel Club Rules. The Authorities of this show may decline to accept entries and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the Show / Trials on account of disease or viciousness.
- 2. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show / Trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 3. The Show / Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident. loss or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during theses Show / Trials.
- 5. The owner of a dog entered in these Show / Trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 6. Dogs entered in the OPEN CLASS must have a CKC Individual Registration Number, a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN), or for Miscellaneous breeds a CKC Certification Number.
- 7. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds. All dogs must be kept on a lease.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Dogs are to be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS only. Please dispose "Poop" and garbage in the appropriate bins.
- 9. Any dog excused by the Show Chairman or the Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the Show .
- 10. Any person, either within or outside the judging ring, who does anything calculated to attract or distract or otherwise affect in any way the attention, of department, or performance of a dog under judgment, may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers in the best interests of the Club, of the Judge may take summary actions.
- 11.It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 12. This is a Non-Smoking Show.
- 13. No Dogs shall be left in Vehicles for any reason or for any length of time. This will be strictly enforced. Those who are caught doing so shall be evicted from the show.
- 14. Exhibitors are expected to know the Canadian Kennel Club Dog Show Rules. Copies can be obtained at the Canadian Kennel Club or on line.

Border Crossing: Government Regulations require a Rabies Certificate to bring a dog into Canada. The Certificate must be dated 30 days prior to entry

PARKING-Pacific Kennel Club July 23-26, 2015

Prepaid RV Overnight Parking and Day Tenting enter at www.dogshow.ca

Reservations are strongly recommended. Deadline for entry July 08, 2015 noon PDT. Prepaid reservations will be given priority. Cost \$35.00/day.

Drive-ins unreserved parking after deadline, will be awarded only if space is available and after all reservations have been assigned \$45/night exact cash only/night.

NOTE: There is No Power of Septic Service Available. No gray or black water shall be dumped on the ground. Space is limited so book early. Generator and motor exhaust pipes must have extensions to vent low above 10 ft. straight up. There are noise restrictions.

RV Spaces are approximately 25 x 40' All X-pens and tow Vehicles Motor homes etc. must fit into this space if more space is required, additional sites must be reserved and paid for. Ground protection MUST be provided for generators. No dumping of gray or black water on site.

Reserved Day Grooming Area tenting \$15.00/day reservations are strongly recommended. Deadline for day-tenting is July 8, 2015, noon PDT. Unreserved day tent space is \$20.00 cash/day and will be awarded only after those with reservations have been assigned a space. Space is to accommodate one 10 x 10 tent and one vehicle. There is NO overnight parking or camping in this area. Pens and tents may be left overnight at owners risk. All vehicles and dogs must be removed daily.

DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

12 to 18 Months Class—This class shall be for dogs at least 12 months of age on the day of the Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this Specialty

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC

Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog.

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) the number of championship points shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.
