SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR LABRADOR RETRIEVERS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed & colour

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Gun Dog - shall be for any dog that has earned a title at WC Test, Hunt Tests or a placement at a Field Trial

Parade of Champions - is open to any titleholder of any country. Dog must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition only.

Note: Parade of Champions- Owners are requested to submit a resume of their dogs' accomplishments at the time of entry - limit 100 words.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class	for Labradors at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
Senior Class	for Labradors at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
12-18 Open	for Labradors s at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 9 years	for Labradors at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years
9 up to 11 years	for Labradors at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years
11 years of age and older	for Labradors 12 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps
 10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps
 25% will be retained for administrative purposes

50% remaining of the entry fees will be divided as follows:
 Classes with 4 or more – 1st – 40%, 2nd – 30%, 3rd – 20%, 4th – 10%
 Classes with three – 1st – 50%, 2nd – 30%, 3rd – 20%
 Classes with two – 1st – 60%, 2nd – 40%, classes with One – 1st 100%

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights

"A" Classes	for dogs handled by owner or immediate family member through all exercises.
"B" Classes	for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCh. degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.

Open A	for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada.
Open B	for dogs who have earned a C.D. in Canada
Utility A	for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D. in Canada.
Utility B	for dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada
Exhibition Dogs	6 months & over, not in competition.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Brace Class - is open to any two dogs of either sex which have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that they be of the same sex. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class except that any non-qualifying score of an exercise will be automatically a zero for that exercise rather than less than 50%.

Team Class is open to any four dogs of either sex which have attained no less than a CD degree in Canada. It is not necessary that they be of the same sex. The Team Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class except that any non-qualifying score of an exercise will be automatically a zero for that exercise rather than less than 50%.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms

Novice A	for dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Novice B	For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.
Advanced A	for dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Advanced B	For any dog that has earned the RN title.
Excellent A	for dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and is handled by the owner or immediate family member
Excellent B	For any dog that has earned the RA title.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class	for Labradors at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
Senior Class	for Labradors at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
12-18 Open	for Labradors s at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

11 years of age and older	for Labradors 12 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

- The Show & Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler .
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The ALRC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The ALRC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MGRC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.
- The precincts of the show shall be the building and the entrances to it..
