Important Note Regarding Emails

& Faxes – it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR CLUMBER SPANIELS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Best Altered Male, Best Altered Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

NOTE: Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brace Class – For two Clumber Spaniels competing together as a brace.

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Hunting Dog/Bitch - shall be for any dog/bitch that has earned at least a leg towards a JH, SH, MH title under AKC/CKC rules & regulations. Only dogs with these titles qualify. Must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class	for Clumbers at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 Months
Senior Class	for Clumbers at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12months
12-18mth Class	for Clumbers s at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 10 years	for Clumbers at least 7 years of age up to and including 10 years.
10 Years +	for Clumbers who are 10 years of age and over.

SPECIALTY SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES – Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows: 25% of total fees will be retained by the club for administration. Best in Sweepstakes will receive 25% of total entry fee. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive 20% of total entry fee. First Place winners in each class will divide the remaining 30% of the total entry fee.

Rosettes will be given for up to Four Awards of Merit to be chosen at Breed Level. One for every 10 dogs competing at the breed level.

A Rosette and prize will be awarded to clumber earning the highest qualifying score at the HKC Sunday obedience trial (am) and rally trial (pm).

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 21

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

SECTION 2 -

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show & Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The CSCC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight. **NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT.**
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The CSCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the CSCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.
- The precincts of the show shall be the building and the entrances to it.
