# **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non-member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

**NO POST-DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF** checks are subject to a charge of \$50.00 **N.S.F.** checks are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

**Attention Foreign Exhibitors**: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted checks will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a check in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark checks "Payable in

Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship Points.** 

# CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

# TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)-\* Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account. \* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

PRIZES Rosettes will be offered for BIS, RBIS, BPIS, BBPIS, Rosette will be awarded

to Group 1st through Group 4th, BPIG, BBPIG.

CATALOGUE Catalogues are available on a "pre-order basis" at \$8.00 per copy. Pre-ordered

catalogues must be paid for at time of ordering (with entry). Catalogues will be available at the door for \$10.00 but on a first come first served basis.
