Directions to the Show Site

Niagara Regional Exhibition & Fairgrounds

1100 Niagara Street, Welland, Ontario

From Toronto/Hamilton

- From the QEW towards Niagara.
- Just before St. Catharines, take the exit to ON 406 SOUTH, towards Thorold/Welland/Port Colborne. Continue on Hwy 406 for 21 kms.
- Take exit 21 for Merritt Road/Niagara Regional Road 37 WEST. Continue on Merritt Road for 1 km.
- Turn left onto Niagara Street/Niagara Regional Road 50. Destination will be on your left.

From the QEW West (Queenston - Lewiston Bridge or Peace Bridge)

1. From the Queenston - Lewiston Bridge, continue onto General Brock Parkway WEST to the Queen Elizabeth Way/QEW
 2. From the Peace Bridge, the Peace Bridge becomes Queen Elizabeth Way/QEW.
- Take Exit 21 towards County Road 47/Lyons Creek Road
 - Turn left onto Lyons Creek Road
 - Turn left onto Montrose Road
 - Turn right onto Schisler Rd/Regional Rd-27. Continue to follow Regional Rd-27.
 - At the roundabout and take the 1st exit onto ON 406 NORTH towards St. Catharines.
 - Take exit 21, Merritt Road/ Niagara Regional Road 37. Continue on Merritt Road for 1 km.
 - Turn left onto Niagara Street/Niagara Regional Road 50. Destination will be on your left.

From the Ramada Plaza Hotel (7389 Lundy's Lane, Niagara Falls, ON)

- From the hotel, turn right onto Lundy's Lane.
- Continue for 8 kms to RR 20 WEST (no turn, continue straight for another 10 kms)
- Turn left onto Merrittville Hwy/Regional Road 50. Destination will be on your left.

Entering Canada by land – COVID requirements



ArriveCAN

Pre-entry testing is not required

- Pre-entry tests are not required for fully vaccinated travellers entering Canada by land, air, or water. You must still use **ArriveCAN** within 72 hours before your arrival to Canada.
- Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated children under the age of 12 are not required to provide a valid pre-entry test result, if they are accompanying a fully vaccinated adult. Children who are less than 5 years old are not required to test, regardless of their vaccination status.

Mandatory use of ArriveCAN mobile app

- **ArriveCAN** continues to be mandatory for all travellers to Canada. It is also required to qualify for the fully vaccinated traveller exemption from quarantine and testing. If you don't submit your travel information and proof of vaccination using ArriveCAN you could be fined \$5,000.
- You must use the ArriveCAN mobile app or sign in on a computer to enter your proof of vaccination and travel information.
- Use the latest version of the free ArriveCAN app. It's available from the [Google Play Store](#) and the [App Store for iPhone](#).
- To be ready for your trip, [create your free ArriveCAN account](#)
- Proof of vaccination and travel documents can be saved in your ArriveCAN traveller profile before any planned travel
- To get an ArriveCAN receipt, submit your travel and vaccination information within 72 hours before your arrival to Canada

No smartphone?

- You still need to enter your information and submit in ArriveCAN up to 72 hours before your arrival in Canada or before a short trip outside Canada. [Sign in to ArriveCAN from a computer](#) to get your ArriveCAN receipt.
- Print your receipt and take it with you when you travel.

What you need at the border crossing

1. ArriveCAN receipt (with letter A, I or V beside your name)
2. Proof of vaccination that was uploaded onto ArriveCAN app
3. Copy of travel document that was also uploaded onto ArriveCAN app (passport)

Don't forget to also bring your dog's rabies and vaccine certificate with you!
