Tyee KC Versatility Trophy

Tyee KC will offer a perpetual trophy which will remain in the possession of the club but a keeper will be given to the winner. To be eligible for this award a dog must be entered in at least 3 or more events which will include:

Agility	Obedience	Rally Obedience	Herding Test
Lure Coursing	Draft Test	Canine Good Neighbour	

- The dog must achieve a pass or a qualifying score to be included

- Each event that they pass or get a qualifying score in will be worth **10 pts** so the more events they do the more points they can get

- As there are 4 Obedience, Rally and Agility trials any one pass or qualifying score can be used from the entire weekend

If there is a tie – the Tyee KC Performance Spectacular committee will use their tie-breaker method (scores, etc.) to decide the winner

The trophy will be awarded Sunday after all events are completed

Attention U.S. Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please DO NOT mark cheques PAYABLE IN CANADIAN FUNDS or AT PAR. They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Every dog entered in a CKC approved Agility trial must be: registered with the CKC, or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification Number (MCN), or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN).

The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed, neutered or debarked, may not be lame, may not compete if it has tape or bandages.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

(EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011)

- A) AN ANNUAL FEE FOR AWARDS AND TITLES WILL BE CHARGED TO A CANADIAN NON-MEMBER OF CKC. THE FEE WILL MATCH THE ERN FEE.
- B) IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE AWARDS/TITLES EARNED, THE NON-MEMBER WILL HAVE THE OPTION TO BECOME A CKC MEMBER OR PAY THE NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITHIN 30 DAYS OF NOTIFICATION WILL RESULT IN ALL AWARDS AND TITLES BEING CANCELLED.
- C) ALL PREMIUM LISTS WILL CARRY A NOTE STATING THE FEES APPLY ONLY TO DOGS WHOLLY OWNED BY NON-MEMBERS AND IS NOT APPLICABLE TO CKC MEMBERS

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (FOREIGN BORN/FOREIGN OWNED DOG)

FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING CKC EVENTS TO OBTAIN CHAMPIONSHIP STATUS AND OBEDIENCE TITLES AND DEGREES. INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION IS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR FOREIGN BORN, FOREIGN OWNED DOGS. FOREIGN EXHIBITORS MAY APPLY FOR AN ERN (EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER). THIS NUMBER MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF OBTAINING POINTS, SCORES OR AWARDS TO AVOID CANCELLATION. EXHIBITORS MAY SUBMIT A PHOTOCOPY OF THE DOG'S FOREIGN REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE AND THE APPROPRIATE FEE (\$59.40 CANADIAN) ALONG WITH A LETTER OF REQUEST TO THE CKC. THIS ERN NUMBER REPLACES A CKC INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR ENTERING CKC EVENTS ONLY.

CANINE COMPANION NUMBER

AS OF JULY 1, 2014 MIXED BREEDS AND UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS ARE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN THE CKC PERFORMANCE EVENTS OF OBEDIENCE, RALLY AND AGILITY, PROVIDED THAT THE CLUB IN QUESTION HAS SO DECLARED IN IT'S PREMIUM LIST.

TO ENTER ANY TRIAL, THE DOG MUST HAVE A CCN NUMBER. A DOG IN THIS CATEGORY MAY NOT BE ENTERED AS 'LISTED'. THE APPLICATION FORM FOR THE CCN (CANINE COMPANION NUMBER) CAN BE FOUND ON THE CKC WEBSITE, UNDER FORMS ON-LINE, REGISTRATION.

SAME DAY MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED (6.8.1)

A DOG THAT IS INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED IN THE RECORDS OF THE CKC OR HAS AN EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) OR A MISCELLANEOUS CLASS CERTIFICIATION NUMBER (MCN) OR A PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN) OR A CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (CCN) AND HAS RECEIVED 3 QUALIFYING SCORES FROM AT LEAST 2 DIFFERENT JUDGES, MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THE NEXT LEVEL PROVIDED THAT A WRITTEN OR ELECTRONIC REQUEST IS RECEIVED NOT LESS THAN 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF EACH TRIAL OR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONDITIONS ADVERTISED IN THE PREMIUM LIST.

BORDER CROSSING

CANADIAN GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE THAT A DOG ENTERING INTO CANADA MUST HAVE A VALID RABIES CERTIFICATE; THE RABIES CERTIFICATE MUST BE DATED 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY.

BITCHES IN SEASON (6.10.1 & 6.10.2)

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT PERMITTED TO COMPETE.

THE JUDGE OF AN AGILITY TRIAL MUST REMOVE FROM COMPETITION ANY BITCH IS SEASON. WHEN A BITCH COMES INTO SEASON AFTER ENTRY HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE TRIAL SECRETARY, A VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE, CERTIFYING THE BITCH WAS IN SEASON WITHIN THE 10 DAY PERIOD PRECEDING THE TRIAL, MUST REACH THE TRIAL SECRETARY ON OR BEFORE THE START OF THE TRIAL. THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB MUST REFUND THE ENTRY FEE, SERVICE CHARGE AND LISTING FEE. THE REFUND AND THE TERMS THEREOF MUST BE CLEARLY STATED IN PREMIUM LIST. UPON PROOF AS PER THE ABOVE RULE ANY BITCH THAT COMES IN SEASON TO INTERFERE WITH THEM ENTERING THE TRIAL, MONIES WILL BE REFUNDED. A QUALIFYING SCORE IS 85 POINTS OR MORE OUT OF 100, WITH NO NON- QUALIFYING DEDUCTIONS.

A QUALIFYING SCORE IN MASTER EXCELLENT is 100

RUNNING ORDER

LIST OF OBSTACLES & PERFORMANCE STANDARDS – CHAPTER 10

All courses must have clearly designated start and finish lines, and all obstacles/jumps must be clearly and sequentially numbered. The course layout for each class must be posted in an easily accessible area at least 1/2 hour before the start of the class.

Elements for all classes will include some of the following (see Chapter 11 for details):

A-FRAME 5'6" PAUSE TABLE WEAVE POLES OTHER JUMPS TRIPLE BAR JUMP DOG WALK OPEN TUNNEL BAR JUMPS DOUBLE BAR JUMP TIRE (CIRCLE) JUMP TEETER CLOSED TUNNEL PANEL JUMP ASCENDING SPREAD JUMP ONE BAR JUMP

CLASSES – CHAPTER 8

8.1 CLASSES DIVISION

8.1.1 There are three types of class divisions, Regular, Selected and Veterans. A dog entering an Agility trial will be entered in the Regular class unless the entry specifies the dog is entered in the Selected or the Veterans class. Each of these is included in Standard Class, Jumpers with Weaves Class, and Points and Distance Class.

8.1.2 A dog that has completed the requirements for a Novice or Intermediate title in any class is not required to move up to the next level.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD BE FAMILIAR WITH THE CURRENT JANUARY 1, 2014 CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB AGILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS – CHAPTER 8

8.5.1 THE FOLLOWING JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS SHALL BE USED IN ALL TRIAL CLASSES:

8" – FOR DOGS 10" AND UNDER AT THE WITHERS 12" – FOR DOGS OVER 10" UP TO AND INCLUDING 14" 16" – FOR DOGS OVER 14" UP TO AND INCLUDING 18" 20" – FOR DOGS OVER 18" UP TO AND INCLUDING 22" 24" – FOR DOGS OVER 22" AT THE WITHERS

THE FOLLOWING JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS SHALL BE USED IN ALL SELECTED CLASSES:

4" - FOR DOGS 10 INCHES AND UNDER AT THE WITHERS

8" – FOR DOGS OVER 10" UP TO AND INCLUDING 14"

12" – FOR DOGS OVER 14" UP TO AND INCLUDING 18"

16" – FOR DOGS OVER 18" UP TO AND INCLUDING 22"

20" – FOR DOGS OVER 22" AT THE WITHERS

THE FOLLOWING JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS SHALL BE USED IN ALL VETERAN CLASSES:

4" – FOR DOGS 10 INCHES AND UNDER AT THE WITHERS 4" OR 8" – FOR DOGS OVER 10" UP TO AND INCLUDING 14"

8" – FOR DOGS OVER 14" UP TO AND INCLUDING 18"

12" - FOR DOGS OVER 18" UP TO AND INCLUDING 22"

16" - FOR DOGS OVER 22" AT THE WITHERS

NOTE: It is the handler's choice to enter a Veteran one or two jump heights lower than its Regular jump height, but must be entered in the same height for a set of trials.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
