Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved</u> Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies
 vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this
 country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs
 less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

	BABY PUPPY	dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points
	JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
	SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
	12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
	CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
	BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
	OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
	VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
	SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
	EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
	EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades</u>

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two of his get. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
PARADE OF VETERANS	for any dog (not necessarily a champion) 7 years of age or older. <u>Dogs</u> must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only.
PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS	for dogs holding titles in conformation, lure coursing, obedience, rally obedience, scent hurdle racing, agility, flyball, etc. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BIATHLON CLASS	For dogs competing for the High Score Biathlon Prize

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$57.60 + 5% GST.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.
