**Regular Conformation Classes**

- Baby Puppy** 3-6 months of age
- Junior Puppy** A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
- Senior Puppy** A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.
- 12-18 Months** A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.
- Canadian Bred** A dog which was born in Canada.
- Bred by Exhibitor** A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
- Open Class** A dog 6 months of age or older
- Altered Class** For dogs that have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure
- Veterans Class** A dog 7 years of age or older on the day of the event
- Specials Only** Dogs who are Canadian Champions.
- Exhibition Only** Dogs 6 months of age and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of Age and under 6 months on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the Regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 Puppies

**\*NOTE: Baby Puppy Class ~ if the puppy does not yet have a CKC Registration number the Listing Fee of \$9.65 is waived.**

**Non Regular Conformation Classes**

- Stud Dog & Get** Stud Dog and 2 of his Get (owners need not be identical). Stud must be Entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. Get must be Entered in a Regular Class
- Brood Bitch & Progeny** Brood Bitch and 2 Progeny (owners need not be identical). Bitch must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular Class
- Gun Dog** shall be for any dog that has earned at title at WC or Hunt Test or a placement at a field Trial.
- Brace Class** A "Brace Class" shall be judged as a "similar" pair ~ size, gait and stride/ The term "identical" has been replaced by "similar" due to removal of the "same colour", requirement
- Generational** Three or more dogs in a direct generational line, shown together, handled separately, to be judged on similarity of type. Dogs must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only.

**AGILITY TRIALS**

2 Trials Being Held Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup>, July 2013

This event is being held outdoors on grass. Trials will run whether rain or shine. The ring area is 100 feet by 100 feet. There will be no Contact Familiarization available. Electronic timer will be used.

**Move-ups In Agility**

Move ups must be received by the Trial Secretary immediately following the class in which the title was completed. (See CKC Agility Rules).

**Eligibility To Compete In These Agility Trials**

In order to be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, hold an ERN, PEN, or Misc Certificate Number or be eligible for same. Dogs may be spayed, neutered and/or debarked. Dogs must be 18 months of age or older. Dogs may not be lame.

**From Quebec & Ontario** ~ at the Quebec/NB Border you are on route #2, continue to Fredericton, from Fredericton take route #101 and follow as above

**US Exhibitors** ~ traveling on I95 from Houlton Border to Fredericton, stay on I95N entering Canada (NB) .. Continue on NB95N taking exit ramp NB2East. Travel NB2East until you get to Fredericton. The take route #101 and follow as above.

**From Saint John** ~ (Hwy #7) Immediately after the Welsford Irving Gas Station turn left unto hwy #101 and follow directions to Fredericton Junction. Turn right unto Prides Landing Rd, the Tri County Complex will be on your left.

**EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require and Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. send a photocopy of the dog’s Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holder’s name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as “LISTED”, however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

**Puppy Sweeps** These sweepstakes are first divided by sex and the sexes are divided into 4 classes as follows: 3-6 Months, no younger than 3 mo. and no older than 6 mo. on the day of the event; 6-9 Months, no younger than 6 mo. and no older than 9 mo. on the day of the event; 9-12 months, no younger than 9 mo. and no older than 12 mo. on the day of the event; and 12-18 Months, no younger than 12 mo. and no older than 18 mo. on the day of the event.

**Veteran Sweeps** The Veteran Sweeps are first divided by sex and the sexes are divided into classes as follows: 7-9 years, no younger than 7 years and no older than 9 years on the day of the event; 9-11 years, no younger than 9 years and no older than 11 years on the day of the event; and 11 years and older, no younger than 11 years on the day of the event.

**Division of Sweepstake Prizes (both Puppy and Veteran)**

15% of the total entry will be awarded to Best In Sweepstakes

10% of the total entry will be awarded to best of Opposite Sex In Sweepstakes

25% of the total entry will be retained for Administrative purposes

The remaining 50% of the total entry will be dispersed as follows:

An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded for each of the following: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Best of Winners, Best Baby Puppy, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Puppy, Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Bitch, Best Brace, Best Gun Dog, Altered Male, Altered Female, Best Altered. As well, 1st place in each Class as follows: Canadian Bred Male, Canadian Bred Female, Bred By Exhibitor Male, Bred By Exhibitor Female, Veteran Male, Veteran Female, and Generational. Rosettes will be given for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> in each class. Rosettes will be given for up to Four Awards of Merit to be chosen at Breed Level.

An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded for each of the following: High in Trial, High Novice A, High Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, High Open A, High Open B, High Utility A, High Utility B, High Scoring Veteran, High Scoring Toller in each class and also in Trial

Rally Obedience – An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded for each of the following: High qualifying Score in each class, High scoring Toller in each class Rosettes will be given to all Qualifying dogs in both Obedience & Rally; and for 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> in each class.

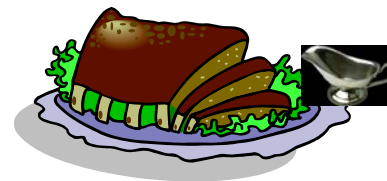

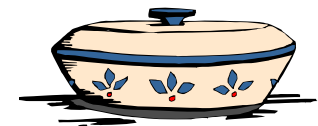
