Regular Classes

(divided by sex)

Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12 - 18 Month, Canadian Bred, Bred by Exhibitor, Open Drop Ear, Open Erect Ear, Specials Only (The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed)

Veterans - open to all dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veterans Male & Female classes will not compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veteran dogs may be neutered or spayed.

Non-Regular Classes

Award of Merit - This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. One Award of Merit is offered at the discretion of the judge for every 10 dogs competing at the Best of Breed level

Exhibition Only - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular classes.

Stud dog & Get - shall be comprised of the stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class

Dam & Progeny - has the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get class

Brace Class - This class shall be for two dogs (not necessarily of the same sex)

Baby Puppy Class - Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the date of the Specialty, Best Baby Male; Best Baby Female ; Best Baby in Breed

Sweepstakes

Please Note: All Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the specialty. This specialty will include Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes as follows:

Juvenile Sweepstakes classes divided by sex - 6 - 9 Mo, 9 - 12 Mos, & 12 - 18 Mo, as of the day of the specialty. Winners of all classes will compete for Best in Juvenile Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Juvenile Sweepstakes

Veteran Sweepstakes classes are to be divided by sex - 7-9 yrs, 10 years and over, as of the day of the specialty. Winners of all classes will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Due to limited grooming space NO private x-pens will be allowed in the building. The Club will provide an indoor exercise area

15.1 Champions and Championship Points

15.1.1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 - 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing is the bred, including Specials only, shall be included in the total.

15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- Have earned at least one 2 point win, either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees however, WILL NOT be refunded.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS AND OBEDIENCE TRIALS. Rulebooks are available from CKC.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) : Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all foreign born and foreign owned dogs that enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration #, but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Forms to apply for an ERN will be available at the show. Or simply send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, with a written request for an ERN number and a check for \$58.85 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials, 200 Ronson Dr., Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ontario. M9W 5Z9

Notice to All Canadian Residents Only

Section 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
