### 15.1 Champions and Championship Points

**15.1.1.** A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 - 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

**15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

- **15.1.3** If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing is the bred, including Specials only, shall be included in the total.
- **15.1.4** If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- **15.1.5** If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in
- **15.1.7** The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determines by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.
- **15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must
- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- (c) Have earned at least one 2 point win, either at the breed or group level.

### MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees however, WILL NOT be refunded

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS AND OBEDIENCE TRIALS. Rulebooks are available from CKC.

**EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**: Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all foreign born and foreign owned dogs that enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration #, but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Forms to apply for an ERN will be available at the show.
