NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number. In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled. **Please Note**: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of **\$25.00**. **N.S.F.** cheques are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship Points.**

MOVING UP TO SPECIALS ~ CONFORMATION

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING and on the appropriate form by the owner or handler at least ONE HOUR prior to the start of the show for which it is being move up.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE CKC

MOVING UP IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY OBEDIENCE

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Obedience Rules may be moved up to the next level of Obedience or Rally Obedience competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial Secretary, in WRITING, by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial. Where one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, TRIAL SCHEDULE PERMITTING.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches coming into season MAY NOT compete in Obedience or Rally-Obedience Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate PRIOR to the commencement of the Trial.

Conformation Junior Handling will be held Sunday 29th Oct 2017. All classes will be offered. Junior Handling on Sunday will be held during the regular noon break. To sign up to participate please contact Rachel Strickland-Haslett at the Show Secretary desk prior to 11:30 a.m.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require and Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

RULES & RULE BOOKS

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please ensure that you familiarize yourself with the following general information

- 1. The building will open 1 hour prior to the start of judging each day of the show (see judging schedule).
- 2. It is recommended that dogs be in the building at least 30 minutes prior to the judging of their breed. Judges are not required to wait for dogs and will adhere as closely as possible to the schedule. The owner and/or handler is responsible for having dogs at ringside when the breed is to be judged. Judging will commence each day at 8:00 a.m. unless entry dictates otherwise.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made when entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the error(s) were made.
- 4. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration, ERN or PEN (Obedience) may enter these shows. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 5. The Show/Trial Superintendent will be in FULL Charge of the Shows & Trials.
- 6. Dogs not entered in either Shows or Trials will not be permitted within the building. The Show Superintendent is authorized to enforce this rule.
- 7. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of Dogs and Exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 8. Due to limited space X-PENS WILL BE LIMITED. Where possible please stack crates.
- 9. For set-up purposes the building will be open on Friday 27th October 2017 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (SHARP).
- 10. Incomplete entries will be returned. PLEASE NOTE: ensure that the complete name and address of the OWNER and that of the AGENT (if applicable) are correctly and completely filled in.
- 11. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT.
- 12. As per the Charlottetown Municipal By-Laws, you must CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG. Failure to do so may result in you being fined.
- 13. As per PEI regulations NO SMOKING is allowed in public places. No smoking is allowed within 15 feet of the entry of a public building.

- 14. The precincts of the show shall be the designated area where the shows and trials are being held within the Eastlink Centre. Parking for exhibitors is to the side of the building at the Park Street Parking Lot. Upon unloading your vehicle it must be immediately moved to the side parking lot.
- 15. DO NOT PARK IN THE FRONT PARKING LOT OR YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE TOWED AT YOUR OWN EXPENSE
- 16. OVERNIGHT CAMPERS AND RV PARKING IS FORBIDDEN ON EASTLINK PROPERTY.
