ERN NOTICE

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and who enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number. The ERN (Event Registration Number) does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes, but rather enables a foreign-owned or foreign-born dog to be awarded titles for the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or FAX a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. The cost is \$59.40 + 5% GST. Dogs may initially be entered as "listed", but the ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Sexually Altered					
	A dog entered in this class must be surgically altered by veterinary procedure. Dogs must be 6 months or older. Judging will take place after Best of Breed. <u>There will be two classes: Altered Male & Altered</u> <u>Female</u> . The dogs will be judged by sex, with ribbons for Winners Male, Winners Female, Reserve Winners Male, Reserve Winners Female, Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Altered in Breed.				

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Dogs entered must also be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules.

Will be divided by sex as follows:

6 to under 9 months on the day of the show

9 to under 12 months on the day of the show

12 to under 18 months on the day of the show

Veteran Sweepstakes

Dogs entered may be spayed/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only. Will be divided by sex as follows:

7 to 10 years on the day of the show

10+ years on the day of the show

Brace

This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and need not <u>be identical ownership</u>. Class shall be judged after Best of Breed. A Brace should be judged as an identical pair - same colour, size, gait, and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A brace must be handled by one person on one lead.

Stud Dog and Get

Entry in this class comprises the stud dog and two or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud dog must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in the Stud Dog and Get class may be spayed / neutered, and must be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only.

Brood Bitch and Progeny

Entry in this class comprises the brood bitch and two or more of her progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood bitch must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in the Brood Bitch and Progeny class may be spayed / neutered, and must be entered in a Regular class as outlined in these rules or for Exhibition Only.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - CONFORMATION

Held under CKC Rules. <u>Classes Offered</u>: Pee Wee (non-competitive) / Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice / Senior Novice / Junior Open / Intermediate Open / Senior Open.

Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Entries: \$2.00 payable at registration. Entries will be taken at the specialty ring on Sunday. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the SSFC specialty.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

This schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded Winners: **DOGS COMPETING*** 2 3-5 6-9 10-12 13 or more 1 POINTS ALLOCATED 0 2 1 3 4 5 *Includes the dog awarded Winners. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall not be included in the calculation. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

PLEASE NOTE -THIS IS AN OUTDOOR CAMPING SHOW. See NACA premium list for details on day tents, grooming tents & RV Parking. Reservations for RV parking are recommended - <u>www.northernalbertacanine.org</u> *Contacts* section (links) has the 2013 RV Reservation Form.

There are NO power hook ups, water-fill or dumping facilities available for RV's for those staying on the grounds. There are no public showers at the show site. There will be warm water and a grooming table on a cement pad for bathing dogs. There are public washrooms inside the building and port-a-potties placed around the show site. Those that require power will have to have their own generators or other form of power with them.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The Show Superintendent will have full control of the Specialty Show, which shall be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. A judge officiating at a show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- 3. Any dog excused by the Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 4. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs & Exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to dog or exhibitor regardless of cause.
- 5. It is expected that anyone participating in this show will be familiar the CKC rules pertaining to such an event. If you have any questions, a CKC Conformation Rule Book is available for viewing at the Show Secretary's table.
- 6. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors and/or handlers to have dogs at ringside when required for judging. Handlers are to report any absentees, and to have assistants at ringside if they have more than one dog entered and might be engaged elsewhere.
- 7. Entries will be acknowledged by email as soon as possible after the closing date.
- 8. All dogs are to be exercised only in designated areas. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the show.
- 9. All dogs must be kept under control at all times.
- 10. Entries withdrawn in writing before the closing date and time will receive a full refund of entry fees. Entry fees shall not be refunded in whole or part after the closing date and time. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the Judge, Show/Trial Superintendent or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been incorrectly entered, no refund will be made.
- 11. All dogs not individually registered in the records of the CKC must pay listing fees.
