Entry Fee \$ 2.00 ~ Register at the Show Secretary table 1 hour before judging starts.

Pee Wee Class: This class is for handlers 4 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 7th birthday. This class is optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded; only participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.

Junior Novice Class: This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open Class: This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who HAVE won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class: This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class: This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who HAVE won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Senior Novice Class: This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open Class: This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who HAVE won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

CKC JUNIOR HANDLING RULES - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016-

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.

NOTICE OF AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", "CKC Obedience Trial Rules", CKC Rally Obedience Rules" and "CKC Junior Handling Rules," and that I (we) agree that the Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, <u>date of birth or sex</u> may be amended on the entry form up $\underline{\text{to one hour BEFORE}}$ the start of the $\underline{\text{SHOW}}$

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES

SUBSTITUE JUDGE

3.3.1 - Substitute Judge - when an advertised judge will not be able to fulfill his assignment, permission from the CKC to substitute the judge is required.... Exhibitors affected by this change may withdraw their entries up to one hour before **the judging of the breed**, notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

8.5.8—In case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show (see sections 3.3.1, 3.5.1, 8.5.4)

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

8.7.1 An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by phone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary no later than the official closing date. If written notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show

FEES

8.8.2 Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

MOVING A DOG TO SPECIALS

8.9.3—When one or more all-breed and /or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled **start of the show** for which the dog is being moved up to.

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All classes must be divided by sex except for Specials Only. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH CLASS: for dogs 12 - 18 months on the day of the shows.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards. Should the owner/breeder be unable to handle the dog in this class, the dog may be moved to the Open Class (at least one hour prior to the judging of the breed in question).

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

MOVING DOGS TO "SPECIALS ONLY": A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least 1 hour prior to the opening of the show. NOTE: Class dogs may be moved to "Specials Only" as long as the registration number is on the "Move Up" Sheet.

12.6 NON REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS: For dogs at least three months of age on the first day of the Show and under six months of age on the day of the show. Will compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Show on Friday. No points are awarded BEST VETERAN: For any dogs over 7 years of age. May be spayed or neutered. Will compete for Best Veteran in Breed & Best Veteran in Group on Saturday. Not eligible for Best of Breed. This class is judged after Best of Breed. No points are awarded. See 2013 Dog Show Rules 12.6.1.(b) and 12.1.6 (e)

BEST BRACE: For two dogs of the same breed. Must be handled by one person on one lead. May be spayed or neutered. Will compete for Best Brace in Breed, Best Brace in Group & Show on Sunday. Judged after Best in Breed, after best Puppy in Group and before Best In Show.

EXHIBITION ONLY: for Baby Puppies (See 12.2.2 below) and all dogs 6 months or older of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

ALTERED CLASS: Altered means dogs which have been spayed or neutered by veterinarian procedure. All Rules and Regulations in the Conformation Rules and Regulations shall apply to this class unless otherwise specified. Dogs must be over 6 months of age

OBEDIENCE AND RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

OBEDIENCE: Classes offered are Pre Novice, Novice A, B and C, Novice Intermediate, Open A and B, Utility A and B, Exhibition Only. RALLY OBEDIENCE: Classes offered are Novice A & B, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B and Exhibition Only. start of the show.

BITCHES IN SEASON

6.5.2 When a bitch comes into season after the entries have closed, the trial giving club must refund the entry fee and listing fee providing the trial giving secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.

MOVING UP A DOG

A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance to these rules may be moved up to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.
