Attention Foreign Exhibitors: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). Simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque, money order or Visa/Mastercard number payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATION

The following classes (divided by sex) will be provided at all shows for all breeds recognized by the Canadian Kennel Club:

Junior Puppy - 6 to 9 months Senior Puppy - 9 to 12 months, and Juvenile - 12-18 month

Canadian Bred - born in Canada, champions in any country excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor - owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open - for all dogs

Specials Only - dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration number and have attained the required points for Championship status.

Exhibition only - for all dogs (not entered for competition)

JUNIOR HANDLING

This event will be held on Saturday during the lunch break. All dogs handled in this competition must be entered in one of the official classes on the day of the event. Rosettes will be awarded for first placement in each class and Best Junior Handler Overall, as designated by the C.K.C.

Classes are as follows:

Pee Wee - ages 4-6;

Junior Novice - ages 7-10 and who have not won 6 first places in the same class; Junior Open - 7-10 years who have won 6 first places;

Intermediate Novice - 11-14 who have not won 6 first places; Intermediate Open - ages 11-14 who have won 6 first places;

Senior Novice - ages 15 to 18 who have not won 6 first places; Senior Open - ages 15-18 who have won 6 first places.

BOOTH SPACE

All booth space is to be booked prior to closing date. We will not accept any booth bookings after the show closing date.

Booths are \$125 for a 10 x 20 space and is on a first come first serve basis.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.
3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or Credit Cards in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **A \$35.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.**
4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
5. Obedience entry fees WILL gladly be refunded to exhibitors whose bitches are in season during our TRIALS and must be withdrawn, IF (a) a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the Trial, OR (b) the bitch is on hand for inspection in the show building prior to the Trial.
6. **Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING to the Show Secretary so as to be received no more than 7 days after closing.**
7. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
8. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be emailed through www.dogshow.ca to each exhibitor or agent.
9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
10. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Show held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
11. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show and Trials Giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
12. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
13. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
14. **ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Anyone not following stop and scoop policy will be excused from the shows and trials. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs, both inside and outside the show building. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to eject from the show anyone who does not clean up after their dog.**

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
