## Judging Schedules

Judging of all classes will not begin before 8:00 am.

On Saturday, August 9, 2014, judging of Rally and Obedience will begin with Trial #1 and will be followed by Trial #2. On Sunday, August 10, 2014, Obedience judging will begin with Trial #3 and will be followed by Trial #4.

Judging schedules and entry confirmations will be sent to entrants after the closing date by email when possible unless mail is specifically requested.

\*A listing fee is required for each dog that does not possess an individual CKC registration number, or if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number (ERN), a Performance Number (PEN) or a miscellaneous Class Certification Number (if designated as a Listed or Miscellaneous Breed with the Canadian Kennel Club). The fee is in addition to each entry for each trial.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Fees are due in Canadian funds. American cheques must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded. Do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par", as they will not be cleared by the banks. Bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds simplify the process.

Females in Season: When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded.

## Rent – A – Ring

A rent-a-ring will be held on Friday, August 8, 2014 from 4:00 to 8:00 pm. The cost will be \$8.00 for 15 minutes. Those that enter will also have use of the rest of the building between 4:00 and 8:00 pm. Please contact Shirley North at [marcusnorth@shaw.ca](mailto:marcusnorth@shaw.ca) to book your slot. Payment by cash or cheque will be accepted.

## CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

Canadian Resident non-CKC members competing with a wholly owned dog cannot win an award or title unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. The fee will match the ERN fee.

## Move Ups

A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN, or a MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the Trial Secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE FIRST TRIAL ON THAT DAY.

## **Rules and Regulations Governing These Trials**

1. Dogs must be kept under control and on leash at all times within the building with the exception of the obedience ring. Dogs not entered in these trials will not be allowed inside the Exhibition Building with the exception of Certified Assistance Dogs.
2. Collars other than those specified in the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations are not allowed within the ring.
3. The BC Lab Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of, accident or injury to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators
4. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called (Sec. 8.6.2). Any judging conflicts must be reported to the steward as early as possible. All efforts will be made to accommodate exhibitors, but judging will not be delayed to do so.
5. If, because of civil disturbance, Act of God, or other events beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is not refund of entry.
6. All children must be under the control of an accompanying adult.
7. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
8. The Club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and its grounds. The Trial Chairman shall have full control of these trials, which are governed by Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) rules.
9. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs, both inside and outside the trial building. Dogs are not permitted in the washrooms.
10. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title shall be allowed to handle a dog in Novice A.
11. A person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle a dog in Open A.
12. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a MOTCh title may not handle dogs in Utility A.
13. The Club reserves the right to refuse entries for any reason.
14. As per CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, no judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial shall be subject to indignities of any kind.
