My Kennel Name SIBRA has been registered with the Kennel Union of Southern Africa for over 25 years. My first homebred litter of Siberians produced 4 Champions. I have owned and bred a number of different breeds through the years, German Shepherds, Airedales, Siberian Huskies, Shibas, Border Collies, English Setters, Chinese Crested, I currently live with Shibas and a Powder Puff Chinese Crested. My first judging appointment was in 1976 and after moving to South Africa, I worked my way through the KUSA's Breed Judges Qualifying Scheme. I have also passed the UK Kennel Club's Conformation Exam. I am approved to judge All Breeds and Best in Show at Championship Show& FCI level.
