Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars ONLY. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or can be viewed online.
- 2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Event Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" **Conformation Show Rules and Regulations** Section 19.7.
- 5. We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.
- 6. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 7. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.

## **TCN FEES**

A CKC TCN fee of \$10.50 (GST Incl.) Canadian or US per dog per show is payable with the entry fee if the entry of the dog does not include a CKC individual Registration number, ERN (Event Registration Number), PEN (Performance Event Number), MCN (Miscellaneous Certificate Number) or Companion Number. The Temporary Competition Number MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCN's will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). If a CKC registration number is received after the closing date but prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue. TCN fees will not be refunded.

#### **ENTRY AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta (RMWHCA) has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in this specialty, and of the holding of this show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

Kindly note that the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta, and/or its agents, may take candid photos, win photos, or videos of the show, including but not limited to, images of the exhibitors and their dogs. Such images may be published by the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta in print or on the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta social media sites without your consent. By entering the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta show, you waive all rights to such images and agree that the Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta may use them for its promotional or educational purposes, and without notice or compensation to you.

## **CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

<sup>\*</sup> includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **no**t be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

## **ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS!**

All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded <a href="here">here</a>.

## **Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada**

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.



# Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta / Wet Noses Inc. COVID-19 Requirements

## **General Required Practices**

- 1. RMWHCA members, judges and exhibitors are required to follow Federal, Provincial, Local and facility guidelines as presented below. Any changes in guidelines between the posting of this Premium List and the starting of each show will also be followed.
- 2. Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 6 feet / 2 Metres or more unless individuals are part of a family or cohort unit.
- 3. Masks are required on the show grounds and when showing your dog. Masks are provided by the exhibitors for their personal use. Masks are required in all common areas where social distancing is not guaranteed.
- 4. Show and Go Rules are in effect once your breed judging is complete you are required to leave the show grounds and return to your vehicle or your camping spot. Do not enter the show grounds more than 1 hour before your estimated breed start time. No crates or ringside tables are allowed around the rings.
- 5. RMWHCA will update their Facebook page throughout the show to advise exhibitors which breed is currently being judged.
- 6. There will be plenty of hand sanitizer around the facility for personal use and sanitizer will be provided in the porta-potty
- 7. Wash hands as frequently as possible. Disinfect gate latches, if touched.
- 8. No handshakes or hugging.
- 9. Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
- 10. Bring your own pen/pencil. No common use pencils, pens or markers will be available.
- 11. As you park at Wet Noses, leave sufficient space between vehicles to allow for effective social distancing.

## Information applicable to all participants

- 1. The show has been limited to 200 humans on the specialty field at any one time. The 200 human limit applies to entrants, judges, RMWHCA members and all persons present (including spouse, significant other, family members).
- 2. Take your win ribbon only if you plan on keeping it. Do not give ribbons back to the RMWHCA.
- 3. The show secretary's designated space will be considered sacred ground. Barriers will be set up using a 6 Feet / 2 Metre perimeter to protect the show secretary. Anyone who violates the space of the show secretary will be asked to leave the show grounds and may not return for the duration of the show. No refunds for entries will be provided in this instance.

#### **Show Practices**

- 1. Each exhibitor will complete a waiver of liability for RMWHCA and Wet Noses Inc as part of their entry (either online entry or mailed entry). No one will be allowed to participate who has not completed the required waiver. If you enter online, please print and bring a copy of your signed waiver. If you enter via a mailed entry, please ensure your paper entry includes a copy of your signed wavier.
- 2. Anyone exhibiting COVID symptoms will be asked to leave the show grounds and will not be allowed to return.
- 3. It is required all exhibitors wear a mask on the show grounds.
- 4. MAINTAIN 6 Feet / 2 Metre SPACING at all times.
- 5. Equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day.
- 6. Wristbands will be issued to all exhibitors and guests provided the guests names are included on the signed waiver.

# Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. **COVID-19 is extremely contagious** and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, Federal, Provincial and Local governments and Federal / Provincial health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, imposed restrictions on the congregation of groups of people.
