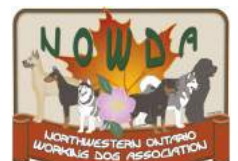

CLASSIFICATIONS

In all breeds, recognized by the CKC the following classes will be provided for divided by sex

Junior Puppy 6 Months and under 9 Months on day of show.

Senior Puppy 9 Months and under 12 Months on day of show.

12-18 Months and under 18 Months on day of show.

Canadian Bred Dogs born in Canada (Champions of any country excluded)

Bred by Exhibitor owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

Open For all dogs Specials Only For Canadian Champions

Veterans— 7 years of age or older on the day of the show, may be spayed or neutered (UNOFFICIAL CLASS)

Exhibition Only For all dogs over 4 Months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC

*****CHANGES TO BABY PUPPY CLASS*****

Baby Puppy class is for dogs 4 months but under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy class DO NOT compete for points.

NOTE:

Baby Puppy will be a separate event – As per the CKC Policy and Procedure manual– A club may choose to have an unofficial event for the Baby Puppy competition where all Baby puppies are entered in a separate event and judged at breed, group and show level by a licensed, or permit or aspiring judge who has successfully completed the “CKC introduction to Judging 101”. This will be Saturday ONLY.

Note: Effectively January 1, 2023 Chapter VI, Shows and Trials Section (F) – Conformation Events Should a club received the number of entries that the show has been limited to before the closing date of the show, a waiting list should be kept by the Event Secretary based on date order and time of entries received. If a dog is withdrawn from a multiple show before the closing date, the next dog on the waiting list must be offered the opportunity to enter the show. Exhibitors that withdraw an entry from a multiple show can not replace that entry with another dog of their own.

Instructions to the show site: FIELD #1

If coming in from the East or West on Hwy 11/17, head south to Hwy 61 heading towards the US border. Turn Left at Chippewa Park Road (Hwy61B/City Road) and follow until you reach the park.

If coming from the USA continue North on Hwy 61 until you reach Hwy 61B and Merge right onto 61B/ City Road and follow to the park

Temporary Competition Numbers: Self-serve Online Registration for Listed Dogs

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number (TCN)*. TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Chapter 15: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Conformation Show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

Section 15.1.8. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level,

CKC Rules & Regulations 4.1.5

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)
